

County Manager Kevin Poe presented a chart showing a breakdown between last year and this year. He noted that there is a decrease for incorporated residents in the General Fund M & O from 8.505 down to 7.85. Looking at the total Millage Rate for the unincorporated area, including General Fund, Fire and Solid Waste, there is a decrease in the rate from 2001 of 10.943 mills to a 2002 rate of 10.9, a .043 decrease. The total decrease in the unincorporated area and decrease to incorporated residents also includes both Rome and Cave Spring.

Chairman Fricks asked how this will affect a \$100,000 house in the incorporated area. County Manager Poe stated that on a \$100,000 house there will be a reduction of about \$26.00. This amount does not include any Homestead Exemption or other reductions.

Commissioner Jennings joined the meeting at this time.
