

RESOLUTION R15-13

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF FORT MEADE, FLORIDA;
AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF THE AGREEMENT(S)
BETWEEN THE CITY OF FORT MEADE AND THE STATE OF
FLORIDA DIVISION OF HISTORIC RESOURCES FOR A 2015/2016
SMALL MATCHING HISTORIC PRESERVATION GRANT.**

WHEREAS, the City Hall of the City of Fort Meade was constructed in 1926 and has been a contributing resource in the Fort Meade Historic District;

WHEREAS, the City Hall has sustained damage from storms and deterioration over the years; and

WHEREAS, through the State of Florida Division of Historic Resources 2015/2016 Small Matching Historic Preservation Grant Program, the City of Fort Meade has been awarded a grant in the amount of \$47,915 to obtain a Historic Structure Report for City Hall and possibly emergency repairs; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fort Meade is a Rural Economic Development Initiative (REDI) Community and as such, is eligible for a waiver of matching funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Commission of the City of Fort Meade, that:

SECTION 1. The City of Fort Meade is recognized as a Rural Economic Development Initiative (REDI) Community.

SECTION 2. The aware of the grant in the amount of \$47,915 from the State of Florida Division of Historic Resources for its 2015/2016 Small Matching Historic Preservation Grant Program is beneficial to the City and its residents.

SECTION 3. The City Commission hereby authorizes the Mayor to execute the Agreement(s) and all necessary paperwork to the State of Florida Division of Historic Resources regarding the 2015/2016 Small Matching Historic Preservation Grant.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.


