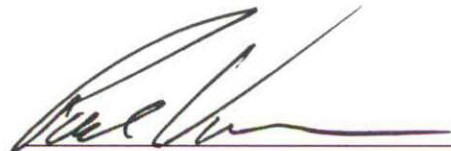

2. **BID #32-21 – WE REQUEST AUTHORIZATION TO ISSUE AN ANNUAL REQUIREMENTS CONTRACT TO LINED RIGHT ATHLETIC FIELD MARKING FOR ESTABLISHING AND MAINTAINING ATHLETIC FIELD MARKINGS PURSUANT TO UNIT PRICES.**
