A. VISITORS/ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF PUBLIC COMMENT CARDS

Tom Rohm, 2503 Springwood Lane – requested that Council include improving city property appearance, such as masonry walls, landscaping, and entrance signs, to their Council goals.

Justin Neth, 1125 E. Renner Rd – requested Council goals meetings be recorded and additional topics of discussion be included in the recorded minutes.

Mr. Johnson explained that the goals work session meetings are properly posted and open to the public. He further explained that the format of the goals development process includes breakout sessions which would make video and audio recording difficult.
