

STANDARD (NON-EMERGENCY) RULE

REGULATION TO EXPAND THE MAPLETON HILL NEIGHBORHOOD PERMIT PARKING ZONE

Having found that the proposed amendment has met all of the requirements set forth in Section 2-2-15 of the BRC, 1981 and the requirements of the adopted Neighborhood Permit Parking Program Regulations, I declare that the Mapleton Neighborhood Permit Parking (NPP) zone is amended to now fully read:

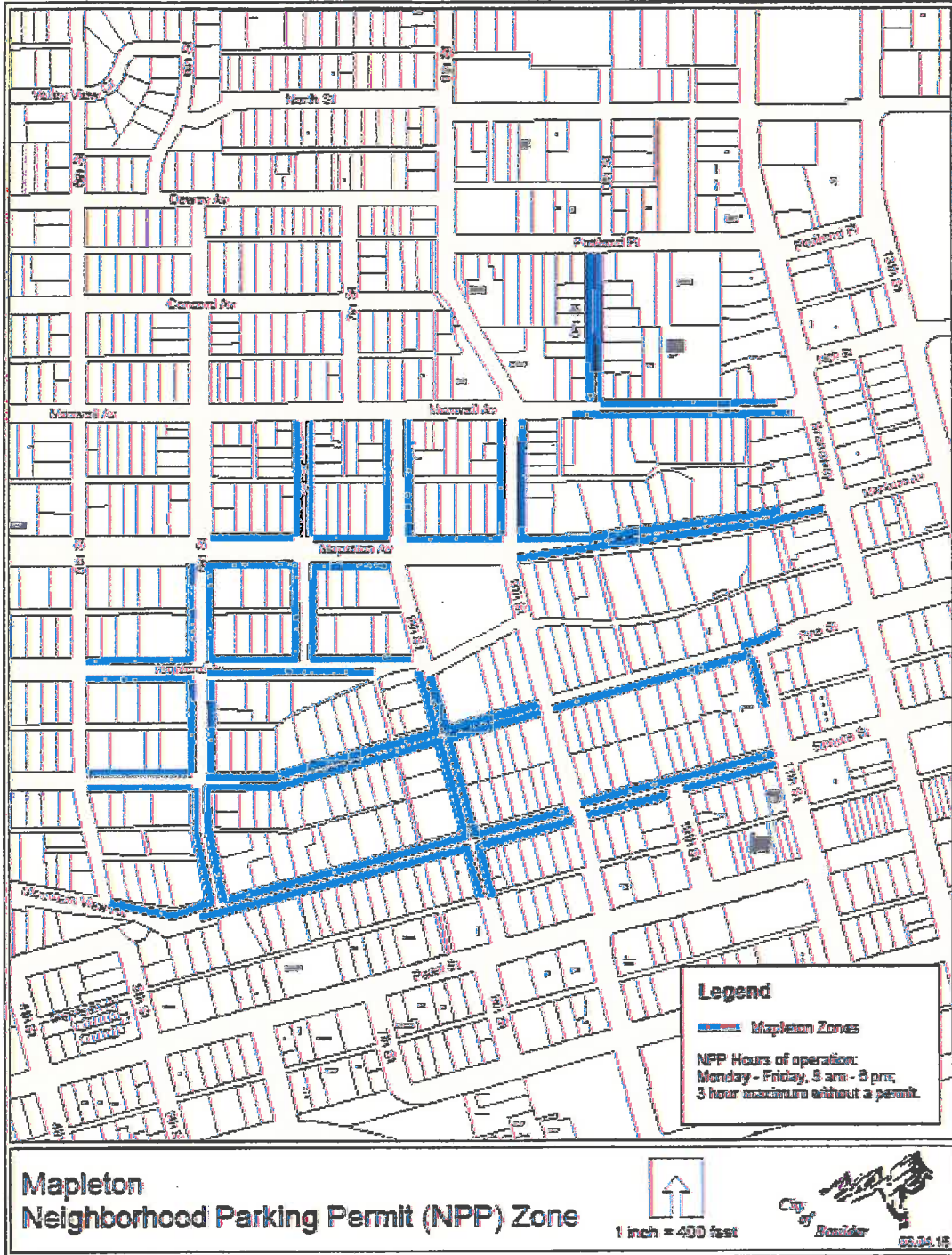
The new boundaries of the zone are now: 600 and 700 block of Highland Avenue (north and south); 1000 -1100 Maxwell (both sides of street), 2300 block of 6th Street and 7th Street (east and west), 2400 block of 10th Street, and 2100 11th Street (west side only); the 2000, 2100, and 2200 blocks of 8th Street (east and west); 600, 700, 800, 900, and 1000 blocks of Spruce Street (north and south); 600, 700, 800, 900, and 1000 blocks of Pine Street (north and south); 1100 block of Pine Street from 1103 through 1109 on the north and including 1104 on the south; 800 block of Mapleton Avenue (north); 600, 700, and 1000 blocks of Mapleton Avenue (north and south); 1100 block of Maxwell from 1111 through 1125 on the north, and from 1100 through 1134 on the south; the 2300 block of 9th (east and west) ; the 2400 block of 8th (east and west) ; the 2400 block of 7th (east and west); the 2200 block of 6th (east and west); the 500 block of Pine (north and south), and the 500 block of Highland (north and south).

The zone will be designated with a "color-code" restriction on public parking as defined in the Neighborhood Permit Parking Program Regulations in effect May 30, 1997 or thereafter. Signs will be posted throughout the zone that read: 3 Hour Parking, One Time Only Per Day, 8:00 AM to 6:00 PM, Monday through Friday, In This Blue Zone, Except by Permit.

Up to four commuter permits per block face will be available for purchase by non-zone residents on a quarterly basis. Commuter permits will be allocated to individuals by a lottery held every two years beginning in 1997.

1. To the extent only of any conflict, this rule supersedes any conflicting rules or parts of rules, including without limitation, 02-2-15.D(10).
2. This rule covers all land shown on the accompanying marked map. Specification on the map of one or more features on the map shall not limit the rule to those features alone.

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The Adopting Authority establishes this rule to expand the Mapleton Neighborhood Permit Parking Zone.
