AMENDMENT TO EMPLOYEE HANDBOOK ADOPTED 5-15-18

The City of Petal may compensate certain exempt/ salaried employees overtime pay if the Governor has declared a state of emergency. The exempt/ salaried employees shall also be eligible for overtime anytime a Local Declaration of Emergency is declared.

Overtime Compensation for Salaried Personnel

The City of Petal may compensate certain exempt/ salaried employees overtime pay if the Governor has declared a state of emergency. The exempt/ salaried employees shall also be eligible for overtime anytime a Local Declaration of Emergency is declared,

State of Emergency Meals In the event of a state of emergency, the City of Petal may pay for meals for city employees for the duration of the activation,
