MAYOR MARX DECLARED A QUORUM PRESENT AND DECLARED THE CITY COUNCIL IN SESSION.

WHEREAS, MAYOR MARX PRESENTED THE PROPOSED BUDGET AND TAX LEVY FOR FY 2020-2021

WHEREAS, MAYOR MARX NOTED THERE WOULD BE NO TAX INCREASE AGAIN THIS YEAR.

WHEREAS, MAYOR MARX CALLED FOR PUBLIC COMMENT AND QUESTIONS

THEREUPON, DREW BRICKSON ADDRESSED THE BOARD WITH APPRECIATION FOR THE HARD WORK THAT GOES INTO THE BUDGET PROCESS. HE IS GLAD ONLY TWO FIREMEN WILL BE LOST. A FIRE RATING DECREASE WOULD AFFECT HIM BY ABOUT \$78.00 PER YEAR WHICH EQUALS ABOUT TWO MILLS. HE WOULD RATHER HIS MONEY STAY LOCAL RATHER THAN GOING TO AN INSURANCE CORPORATION OUT OF TOWN.

THEREUPON, MIKE LOTT ENTERED THE MEETING.

THEREUPON, DAVID CLAYTON ENTERED THE MEETING.

THEREUPON, DREW BRICKSON STATED HE BELIEVES WE COULD ACHIEVE THE \$150,000 FOR FIRE IF THE ALDERMEN TOOK PAY OR BENEFIT CUTS. HE ASKS IF THERE IS A CONTINGENCY PLAN TO MAKE UP THE \$400,000 EXPECTED FROM THE SALE OF THE 3D SCHOOL BUILDINGS.

THEREUPON, VALERIE WILSON ADDRESSED THE BOARD ASKING IF THE CITY HAS PUT ASIDE ANY MONEY FOR BEAUTIFICATION OF THE CITY. SHE HAS BEEN INVOLVED IN THREE (3) STRATEGIC PLANNING MEETINGS AND BEAUTIFICATION IS ALWAYS WHAT COMES UP. SHE WOULD LIKE TO SEE \$2500.00 PUT ASIDE EACH YEAR FOR "BEAUTIFICATION".

THEREUPON, RICKY SHOWS ADDRESSED THE BOARD. HE AGREES WITH VALERIE ABOUT CLEANING UP PETAL. THINKS PETAL SHOULD HAVE TO PUT THEIR TRASH CANS UP. HE ALSO ASKED ABOUT HIS CULVERTS.

SECTION II. That for the year 2020, there shall be and there is hereby levied on all taxable property, real and personal, within the Petal Municipal Separate School District, within the City of Petal, Mississippi, and within the added territory outside the City of Petal for ad valorem taxes for school purposes such levies having been authorized by the Board of Trustees of said School District by order entered on it's minutes and certified to the Mayor and Board of Aldermen, the following levies to be collected on each dollar of assessed valuation shown on the said ad valorem assessment rolls, to-wit:

That for the year of 2020, there shall be and is hereby levied on all taxable property, real and personal within the corporate limits of the City of Petal, Mississippi, for ad valorem taxes for the following levies to be collected on each dollar of assessed value shown upon the real and personal ad valorem assessment rolls of said City, within the City limits thereof, to-wit:

FOR \$5,000,000.00 GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS, SERIES 2006 PURPOSE LEVIED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 21-33-301 THROUGH 21-33-329 OF THE MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972 AS AMENDED-----3.69
