CANINE TRANSFER, RELEASE AND AGREEMENT TO INDEMNIFY, DEFEND AND HOLD HARMLESS

This is an Agreement between the undersigned, indicated below as TRANSFEREE and the City of Petal (hereinafter, "PETAL") related to PETAL'S transfer of Canine "Leo" (hereinafter, "CANINE").


CANINE is an active duty police dog with the Petal Police Department and is being retired from service. PETAL is transferring permanent ownership of CANINE to TRANSFEREE at the cost of \$1.00. TRANSFEREE is CANINE'S current handler and acknowledges and agrees that:

1. CANINE has been trained and used as a police dog
2. CANINE has suffered extensive physical injuries and is transferred "as is".
3. PETAL makes no representations, warranties, guarantees or statements of any kind or nature regarding (i) the physical or mental health of CANINE, (ii) the training that CANINE has received, (iii) the temperament, disposition, or suitability of CANINE for any use whatsoever.
4. TRANSFEREE'S acquisition of CANINE is desired and entirely voluntary by TRANSFEREE and is not in any way, either actual or implied, a condition of employment by PETAL.
5. Upon transfer, TRANSFEREE shall be fully responsible, financially and otherwise for any care or medical attention required by CANINE, whether or not such care or medical treatment arises out of or in connection with a condition CANINE that existed prior to said transfer, for the natural life of CANINE.
6. TRANSFEREE shall not transfer ownership of CANINE to any other person or entity without prior written permission of PETAL, the request for which shall be agreed to or denied in the sole discretion of PETAL.

In consideration of the benefits derived from being allowed to acquire CANINE, TRANSFEREE, on his behalf and on behalf of his dependents, heirs, or assigns, agrees to release and to indemnify, defend and hold harmless PETAL, its officials, officers and employees from and against any and all claims, demands, defense costs, or liability to any kind or nature arising out of or in connection with TRANSFEREE'S acquisition, or ownership of CANINE after such transfer, including without limitation any claims or actions arising, or alleged to have arisen out of (i) any training given to CANINE by PETAL, or (ii) any attack (by whatever term called) by CANINE on any person or property.



BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Petal, Mississippi:

Chapter 34, Section 95 (a) as originally adopted on December 30, 2016 is hereby amended to read as follows. To-wit:
