

ORDER ACCEPTING TERRITORIES AWARDED IN ANNEXATION

WHEREAS, the City of Petal, Mississippi, (herein "Petal") initiated an annexation proceeding in 2016 in the Chancery Court of Forrest County, Mississippi; and

WHEREAS, the Chancery Court awarded certain lands to the City of Petal on March 25, 2019, at the conclusion of the annexation proceeding; and

WHEREAS, on September 10, 2020, the Mississippi Supreme Court affirmed the Chancery Court's March 25, 2019 Judgement;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Petal, Mississippi that:

1. the Proposed Area of Annexation Three is accepted into the city and made a part of the city as more particularly described as follows:


