line, "AGRINST THE TAX," and the voters shall vote by placing a cross (N) or check [4] opposite their choice on the proposition. When the results of any such referends shall have been canvassed by the city election commission and certified, the city may levy the tax beginning on the first day of the second month following the referendum, only if at least sixty percent (601) of the qualified electors who vote in the election vota in favor of the tax. No public funds shall be used for the purpose of promoting the adoption of the referendum and no city employee may promote the ceferendum during business hours.

Seation 4.0 (1) Persons, firms or corporations liable for the tax imposed under this act shall add the amount of the tax to the sales price and shall collect, insofar as practicable, the amount of tax due from the person receiving the services or products at the time of the payment biperform.

Section 5: Accounting for receipts and expenditures of the funds described in this act must be made separately from the accounting of receipts and expenditures of the general fund and any other funds of the City of Petal. The records reflecting the receipts and expenditures of the funds prescribed in this act shall be audited annually by an independent cartified public accountant, and the accountant shall make a written report of his audit to the governing authorities. The audit shall be made and completed as soon as practicable after the close of the fiscal year, and expenses of such audit shall be paid from the fiscal year, and expenses of such audit shall be paid from the

BE IT SHACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

SECTION 1. As used in this act:

- (a) "City" means the City of Petal, Mississippi
- (b) "Governing authorities" means the governing authorities of the City of Petal, Mississippi
- (c) "Bar" means all places, required by law to possess an on-premises Alcoholic Beverage Control pecals, where beer and/or skobolic beverages are sold for conjunction on the greatest.
- (d) "Restaurant" means all places where prepared food and beverages, including beer and alcoholic beverages, are sold for consumption, whether such food is consumed on the premises of not. The term "restaurant" down not. anolyde any school, hospital, convalescent or nursing home, or any cestaurant-like facility operated by or in connection with a school, hospital, sedical clinic, convalescent or nursing home providing food for students, patients, visitors or their families.
- "Facilities" means tourism and parks and recreation and other related and ancillary facilities

(6) "Notel" or "motel" means a place of lodging that at any one time will accommodate transient guests on a daily or weekly basis...

Section 2. (1) for the purpose of providing funds to promote tourism and improve parks and recreation within the City of Petal, Mississipput, the governing authorities of the City of Petal are suthorized, in their discretion, to levy and collect from the following persons a tax, which shall be in addition to all of the taxes and assessments imposed, The tax shall be imposed on the following persons:

ial A cax upon every person, firm or corporation operating a ber in the City of Peral, at a rate not to exceed three percent (3%) of the gross proceeds of the sales of such bar; and

(b) A tak upon every person, firm or corporation operating a restaurant in the City of Petal, at a rate not to exceed three percent (31) of the gross proceeds of the sales of beer and alcoholic baverages sold for consumption on the presises and all propored foods of such restaurant.

(c) A tax upon every person, firm or corporation operating hotels and motels in the city, in an amount not to exceed three percent (3%) of the gross proceeds from overnight coon rental, exclusive of charges for (bod, telephone, laundry, Deverages and similar charges.

(2) Parsons, firms or corporations liable for the levy imposed under subsection (1) of this section shall add the amount of the levy to the sales pcice of the products and services set out in subsection (1) of this section and shall collect, insofar as is practicable, the amount of the tax due by them from the person cocciving the services or product at the time of payment therefore.

(4) The orocords of such tax, less three percent (3%) thereof which small be retained by the Department of Revanue to defray the cost of collection, shall be paid to the governing authorities of the City of Petai, on or before the fifteenth day of the month in which collected.

15) The proceeds of such tax shall not be considered by the City of Petal as general fund cavanues but shall be dedicated to and expended solely for the purposes specified in this sections.

Section 3 Before any tax authorized under this act may be imposed, the governing authorities shall adopt a resolution declaring its intention to levy the tax, setting forth the amount of such tax to be imposed, the date upon which such tax shall become effective and calling for a referendum to be held on the question. Notice of such intention shall be published once each week for at least three (3) consecutive weeks in a newspaper published or having a general circulation in former County, with the first publication of such notice to be made not less than twenty-one (21) days before the date fixed in the resolution for the election and the last publication to be made not more than seven (7) days before the referendum. At the referendum, all qualified electors of the City of Petal may vote, and the ballots used in such election shall have printed thereon a brief statement of the amount and purposes of the proposed tax levy and the words "FOR THE TAX" and, on a separate
