



VePed Traffic Controls, Inc. made a typographical error on Item 2h, however, this did not change the total amount of their bid. We, therefore, recommend awarding the contract to the low bidder, VePed Traffic Controls, Inc., for \$5,272.04.

Traffic Sign Posts

Six bids were received for this material. Sargent and Sowell, Inc. submitted a partial bid and VePed Traffic Controls, Inc. did not bid the specifications and therefore these two bids should not be considered. The apparent low bidder for the specified material is John Warren, Inc. and we therefore recommend the award of the contract to this company for \$1,697.41.

Traffic Pavement Marking Paint

Cataphote, Division of Ferro Corp., was the only bidder on this item. Their bid was only 4.7% higher than the Engineer's estimate, therefore, we recommend awarding the contract to Cataphote for \$1,922.45.

Raised Reflective Markers and Epoxy Adhesive

Two bids were received for this material. Gulf Industries did not bid specifications but would have been the low bidder even if their substitution was acceptable. We therefore recommend that the low bidder Ray-O-Lite, Division of ITL Industries, Inc. be awarded the contract for \$391.56.

Three (3) copies each of the bid proposals and certified bid tabulation have been forwarded to the Mississippi State Highway Department, along with a copy of our recommendations.
