THEREUPON, Thomas W. Tyner, City Attorney, stated that he would like to present the following Resolution:

R E S O L U T I O N

RESOLUTION FIXING THE AD VALOREM TAX LEVY ON  
REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY FOR TAXES IN THE  
CITY OF PETAL, MISSISSIPPI, AND THE PETAL  
MUNICIPAL SEPARATE SCHOOL DISTRICT FOR THE  
YEAR, 1977

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF PETAL, MISSISSIPPI:

SECTION I. That for the year 1977, there shall be and is hereby levied on all taxable property, real and personal within the corporate limits of the City of Petal, Mississippi, for ad valorem taxes for municipal purposes as indicated, the following levies to be collected on each dollar of assessed value shown upon the real and personal advalorem assessment rolls of said City within the city limits thereof, to-wit:

For General Revenue Purposes -  
Ten and one-half (10.5) mills

Total Levied for Municipal Purposes -  
Ten and one-half (10.5) mills

SECTION II. That for the year 1977, there shall be and there is hereby levied on all taxable property, real and personal within the Petal Municipal Separate School District, within the City of Petal, Mississippi, and within the added territory outside the City of Petal for ad valorem taxes for school purposes, such levies having been authorized by the Board of Trustees of said School District by order entered on its minutes and certified to the Mayor and Board of Aldermen, the following levies to be collected on each dollar of assessed valuation shown on the said ad valorem assessment rolls, to-wit:

A-5595 REVISIONS - MATCHES

For Minimum School Program, levied under the provisions of Chapter 261 of the Laws of 1954, particularly Section 37-25-3 of the Code of 1972, as Amended -  
Five (5) Mills

For District School Operation and Maintenance Fund, levied under the provisions of Section 37-57-35 of the Code of 1972 as amended -  
Fifteen and one-half (15.5) mills

Total levied for school purposes -  
Twenty and one-half (20.5) mills

SECTION III. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.

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
