 - (4) For each 2 inch connection or tap----\$775.00
 - (5) For each 3 inch connection or tap-----\$1,345.00
 - (6) For each 4 inch connection or tap-----\$2,225.00
 - (8) Deleted
- (10) For each sewer tap into the public sewer system, a fee or charge of \$150.00 will be made to the customer.
