(4) For each 2 inch connection or tap-----\$775.00

(5) For each 3 inch connection or tap-----\$1,345.00

(6) For each 4 inch connection or tap-----\$2,225.00

(10) For each sewer tap into the public sewer system, a fee or charge of \$150.00 will be made to the customer.
