A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE REAL AND PERSONAL AD VALOREM ASSESSMENT ROLLS OF THE CITY OF PETAL, MISSISSIPPI, AND THE MUNICIPAL SEPARATE SCHOOL DISTRICT WITH ADDED TERRITORIES, FOR THE YEAR 1979 EXCLUSIVE OF MOTOR VEHICLES, AS CORRECTED AND EQUALIZED, SUBJECT TO THE RIGHTS OF PARTIES IN INTEREST TO BE HEARD ON ALL OBJECTIONS MADE BY THEM IN WRITING AT THE MEETING OF THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN, COMMENCING NOVEMBER 6, 1979, AND SUBJECT TO FURTHER CHANGES AND CORRECTIONS BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN AS AUTHORIZED BY LAW

WHEREAS, the matter of the approval of the assessment of real property and the assessment of personal property, exclusive of motor vehicles, for the year 1979, came on for consideration before the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Petal, Mississippi; and,

WHEREAS, it appears that the Tax Assessor of the City of Petal, Mississippi, has duly prepared and completed the real ad valorem assessment rolls for said City of Petal, and has filed the same with the City Clerk on September 27, 1979, and has completed the personal ad valorem assessment rolls for the said City of Petal, and has filed the same with the City Clerk on October 16, 1979, in the manner provided by law; and,

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Aldermen find that the Tax Assessor prepared the 1979 real and personal ad valorem assessment rolls and has made an affidavit and appended the same to each of the rolls as provided by law that the said affidavit shows and the Mayor and Board of Aldermen hereby find that the said Tax Assessor has faithfully endeavored to ascertain and assess all persons and property in the City of Petal, Mississippi, and that said Assessor did not omit any person or thing, and did not place upon or accept an underevaluation of any property through fear, favor or partiality; that the Assessor has required every taxpayer to make the oath required to be taken by the person rendering a list of his taxable property whenever possible; that the said Assessor filed the said real and personal rolls, under oath, as well as a list showing the name of each taxpayer, who failed or refused to make an oath to the personal tax list; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Aldermen have, at this regular meeting on October 16. 1979, duly received and considered the said assessment rolls of real and personal property and have proceeded to change, correct, revise and equalize said assessments in the manner provided by law; and,

WHEREAS, the said assessment rolls of real and personal property should be approved subject to objections of parties in interest as provided by law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Board of Alderman of THE City of Petal, Mississippi:

SECTION I.

That the ad valorem assessment rolls of the real property of the City of Petal for the year 1979, showing total assessments in the amount of \$10,233,000, and the ad valorem assessment rolls of personal property for the year 1979, exclusive of motor vehicles for the City of Petal, showing total assessments in the amount of \$1,157,560, and

That the ad valorem assessment rolls of the real property of the Petal Municipal Separate School District for the year 1979, showing total assessments in the amount of \$6,097,050, and the ad valorem assessment rolls of personal property for the year 1979, exclusive of motor vehicles for the Petal Municipal Separate School District, showing total assessments in the amount of \$3,419,260.

Be, and each said roll and assessments therein are, hereby approved as changed, corrected, revised and equalized, subject to the rights of the parties in interest to be heard on any objections hereafter made by them as herein provided, and subject to any further changes and corrections by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen as authorized by law.

SECTION II.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a public notice shall be published in the Hattiesburg American, a legal newspaper published in the County of Forrest, and having a general circulation in the City of Petal, Mississippi, at least two times, on dates

to be designated therefor by the City Clerk, the first publication of which shall be at least ten (10) days prior to the regular meeting of the Mayor and Board of Aldermen on November 6, 1979, notifying the public and taxpayers of the City of Petal, Mississippi, that the said real and personal ad valorem assessment rolls for the year 1979, and the assessments therein have been corrected, revised, equalized and approved by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen, and they are now ready for inspection and examination by the public and that any objections thereto must be filed in writing with the City Clerk at the City Hall Post Office Box 564, Petal, Mississippi, 39465, on or before 12:00 o'clock noon on November 6, 1979, that at 7:30 o'clock P. M., on said date, the Mayor and Board of Aldermen will convene in a regular meeting and commence hearing and considering said objections, if any, to said rolls and assessments, and that the said Mayor and Board of Aldermen will continue such hearings from day to day thereafter until all taxpayers and parties in interest who have so filed written objections to any of said rolls or assessments shall have been heard, and such objections heard and disposed of, and proper corrections, if any made in said rolls and assessments.

SECTION III.

That the said notice shall be signed by the Mayor and City Clerk and shall be directed to the public and taxpayers in substantially the following form, to-wit:

"PUBLIC NOTICE"

TO THE PUBIC AND TAXPAYERS OF THE CITY OF PETAL, MISSISSIPPI AND THE PETAL MUNICIPAL SEPARATE SCHOOL DISTRICT

You are hereby notified that the ad valorem assessment rolls of real and personal property in the City of Petal, Mississippi, and the Petal Municipal Separate School District, exclusive of motor vehicles, and the assessments therein have been filed, equalized and approved by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Petal, Mississippi, according to law, subject to the right of the public and taxpayers to object to any of said assessments.

You are hereby notified that the said rolls are now ready for inspection and examination by the public and taxpayers in the office of the City Clerk, City Hall, 119 West 8th Avenue, Petal, Mississippi, 39465, and that any objection to said rolls, or any assessments therein contained shall be made in writing and filed with the City Clerk of the City of Petal, Mississippi, at the aforesaid address on or before 12:00 o'clock noon on November 6, 1979, and that all assessments to which no written objections have been filed will then and there be finally approved by the said Mayor and Board of Aldermen. All assessments to which written objections are made will be heard and determined by the said Mayor and Board of Aldermen and the said assessment rolls will thereupon and then be finally approved.

You are further notified that the said Mayor and Board of Aldermen will convene at said meeting at 7:30 o'clock P. M., November 6, 1979, and then commence hearing any such objections to said rolls and assessments and will remain in session from day to day thereafter considering such objections until all parties in interest have been heard and such objections determined and disposed of, and until any proper corrections shall have been made in said rolls, whereupon they will then and there be finally approved by the said Mayor and Board of Aldermen as provided by law.

SECTION IV.

That this Resolution will be in force and effect from and after its passage.
