RE: Sanitary Sewer Repairs

Gentlemen:

An inspection of the sanitary sewer system was made on May 12, 1978, by FEMA, MAW, myself and Mr. Powell, who surveyed the damages caused by the recent flood. After the completion of the survey, it was found that it will be necessary to replace 8" sewer line along Ford Street, or approximately 300 feet, to repair the sewer line at 102 Cochran Street, the 12" inch sewer line on South George Street, the 8" inch sewer line on Mamie Street east of the pumping station, the 8" inch sewer line North of Mamie Street for approximately 100 feet, located on private property and the 10" inch sewer line on Holmes

Street. These repairs have become an emergency since they have become a danger to the traveling public and also have permitted infiltration and sand to enter the lines at these particular places. It is my recommendation that these repairs be done immediately to prevent further damage to the sanitary sewer system.

Also, it has become an emergency to repair one of the sewer lift pumps located at the lagoon. This should be done immediately since only one pump is now in operation.
