ORDINANCE 1986 (67)
AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR IDENTIFICATION
AND NUMBERING OF ALL ROADS, HIGHWAYS, STREETS
AND DWELLING HOUSES NOT OTHERWISE OFFICIALLY
NAMED OR NUMBERED

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

WHEREAS, all unidentified streets shall be named or numbered by December 31, 1987; and

WHEREAS, said street shall be named and numbered in accordance with Mississippi House Bill 782; and

WHEREAS the City of Petal shall be the official source of new street numbers for all existing and future structures; and

WHEREAS, the Petal City Board of Aldermen shall maintain a set of city maps, designated as "official", and shall update these maps to show new streets and new structures. Such information shall be provided to the State Highway Department for the purpose of allowing the Highway Department to update its maps.
