## ORDINANCE 1980 (46-A)

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FLOODPLAIN MANAGEMENT ORDINANCE;  
AMENDING CERTAIN DEFINITIONS AND CHANGING THE APPEALS  
PROCEDURE FOR AGGRIEVED PARTIES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN  
OF THE CITY OF PETAL, MISSISSIPPI:

SECTION 1. That Ordinance 1980 (46) be amended as follows:

ARTICLE 2. Definitions

ADDITION: In Article 2 and Article 5 Section B (3) and (4) or where ever the term "mobile home" appears, it shall be amended to read "manufactured home"

DELETE: Area of Shallow Flooding means a designated AO of VO zone on a community's Flood Insurance Rate Map (FIRM) with base flood depths from one to three feet where a clearly defined channel does not exist, where the path of flooding is unpredictable and indeterminate, and where velocity flow may be evident.

ARTICLE 2. Habitable Floor means any floor usable for living purposes, which includes working, sleeping, eating, cooking or recreation, or a combination thereof. A floor used only for storage purposes is not a "habitable floor".

## AMENDMENT:

Lowest Floor means any floor useable for living purposes which includes working, sleeping, eating, cooking or recreation, or a combination thereof. A floor used only for storage purposes is not a "habitable floor".

ARTICLE 2. Start of Construction means the first placement of permanent construction of a structure (other than a mobile home) on a site, such as the pouring of slabs or footings or any work beyond the stage of excavation. Permanent construction does not include land preparation, such as clearing, grading and filling; nor does it include the installation of streets and/or walkways; nor does it include excavation for a basement, footings, piers or foundations or the erection of temporary forms; nor does it include the installation on the property of accessory buildings, such as garages or sheds not occupied as dwelling units or not as part of the main structure. For a structure (other than a mobile home) without a basement or poured footings, the "Start of Construction" includes the first permanent framing or assembly of the structure or any part thereof on its piling or foundation. For mobile homes not within a mobile home park or mobile home subdivision, "Start of Construction" means the affixing of the mobile home to its permanent site. For mobile homes within

ARTICLE 2. Start of Construction - cont.

mobile home parks or mobile home subdivisions, "Start of Construction" is the date on which the construction of facilities for servicing the site on which the mobile home is to be affixed (including, at a minimum, the construction of streets, either final site grading or the pouring of concrete pads, and the installation of utilities) is completed.

## AMENDMENT:

Start of Construction (for other than new construction or substantial improvements under the Coastal Barrier Resources Act (P.L. 97-348)), includes substantial improvement, and means the date the building permit was issued, provided the actual start of construction, repair, reconstruction or improvement was within 180 days of the permit date. The actual start means the first placement of permanent construction of a structure (including a manufactured home) on a site, such as the pouring of slabs or footings, installation of piles, construction of columns, or any work beyond the stage of excavation or the placement of a manufactured home on a foundation. Permanent construction does not include land preparation, such as clearing, grading and filling; nor does it include the installation of streets and/or walkways; nor does it include excavation for a basement, footings, piers or foundations or the erection of temporary forms; nor does it include the installation on the property of accessory buildings, such as garages or sheds not occupied as dwelling units or not part of the main structure.

ARTICLE 2. Structure means a walled and roofed building that is principally above ground, as well as a mobile home.

## AMENDMENT:

Structure means a walled and roofed building that is principally above ground, a manufactured home, a gas or liquid storage tank, or other man-made facilities or infrastructures.

SECTION D. (3) Any person aggrieved by the decision of the Zoning Appeals Board, or any taxpayer may appeal such decision to the Circuit Court of Forrest County.

## AMENDMENT:

Any person aggrieved by the decision of the Zoning Appeals Board, or any taxpayer may appeal such decision to the Mayor and Board of Aldermen.

SECTION II. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force on April 3, 1987.

SECTION III. That except as amended herein, Ordinance Number 1980 (46) be and remains in full force and effect.
