Lowest Floor means any floor useable for living purposes which includes working, sleeping, eating, cooking or recreation, or a combination thereof. A floor used only for storage purposes is not a "habitable floor".

ARTICLE 2. <u>Start of Construction</u> means the first placement of permanent construction of a structure (other than a mobile home) on a site, such as the pouring of slabs or footings or any work beyond the stage of excavation. Permanent construction does not include land preparation, such as clearing, grading and filling; nor does it include the installation of streets and/or walkways; nor does it include excavation for a basement, footings, piers or foundations or the erection of temporary forms; nor does it include the installation on the property of accessory buildings, such as garages or sheds not occupied as dwelling units or not as part of the main structure.For a structure (other than a mobile home) without a basement or poured footings, the "Start of Construction" includes the first permanent framing or assembly of the structure or any part thereof on its piling or foundation. For mobile homes not within a mobile home park or mobile home subdivision, "Start of Construction" means the affixing of the mobile home to its permanent site. For mobile homes within

Permanent construction does not include land preparation, such as clearing, grading and filling; nor does it include the installation of streets and/or walkways; nor does it include excavation for a basement, footings, piers or foundations or the erection of temporary forms; nor does it include the installation on the property of accessory buildings, such as garages or sheds not occupied as dwelling units or not part of the main structure.

ARTICLE 2. Structure means a walled and roofed building that is principally above ground, as well as a mobile home.

AMENDMENT:

Structure means a walled and roofed building that is principally above ground, a manufactured home, a gas or liquid storage tank, or other manmade facilities or infrastructures.

SECIION D. (3) Any person aggreived by the decision of the Zoning Appeals Board, or any taxpayer may appeal such decision to the Circuit Court of Forrest County.
