AN ORDINANCE CHANGING AND AMENDING THE COMPREHENSIVE ZONING DISTRICT MAP, ADOPTED AS PART OF COMPREHENSIVE ZONING ORDINANCE NUMBER 1979 (42) OF THE CITY OF PETAL, MS. AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NUMBERS 1979 (42-1) THROUGH 1979 (42-A41) SO AS TO CHANGE THE ZONING CLASSIFICATION OF CERTAIN LAND IN SAID CITY FROM R-2 (LOW TO MEDIUM DENSITY RESIDENTIAL) TO R-F (RURAL FRINGE)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF PETAL, MISSISSIPPI:

SECTION 1. That the Comprehensive Zoning District Map, adopted as part of Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance Number 1979 (42) of the City of Petal, Ms. as amended by Ordinance Numbers 1979 (42-1) through 1979 (42-A41) be and the same is hereby changed and amended as per petition filed in connection therewith so that the land described as:

Commence at the SE corner of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 7, T-4-n, R-12-W, Forrest County, Ms and run West for 721.95 feet; thence run North for 621.35 feet to the Point of Beginning.
