Dear Mr. Mayor:

On behalf of the National Office of the Invisible Empire, Christian Knights of the Ku Klux Klan, I hereby request your written permission to hold a streetwalk/parade in the City of Petal on Sunday, November 13, 1988 from 1:00 to 2:00 PM. We will also be marching in Hattiesburg later in the afternoon. The purpose of our march in Petal is to obtain new recruits for the Christian Knights of the KKK as part of our statewide membership drive here in the Magnolia state.

Sir, we will need to plan a "parade route" that will be acceptable to you and the Petal Town Council and to the Christian Knights. The Christian Knights request that the parade route be at least one mile long, and that we freely be allowed to distribute membership applications and other literature during the course of our march. The Christian Knights desire to march in a prominent downtown area easily asseseible to the White public, and do not want to march in a residential area. Further, we would like to make speeches to the public at the conclusion of the march.

Mr. Mayor, I am a newcomer to south Mississippi and am not well acquainted with the small downtown area of Petal, but I believe it would be proper for us to march to or from the New City Hall Building. I would be more than happy to meet with you and/or officials of the Petal Police Department and/or the Forrest County Sheriff's Department to arrange an appropriate route for the "streetwalk" or "parade" of the Christian Knights of the Ku Klux Klan.

I anticipate that we will have at least twenty-five (25) Klansmen participate in our streetwalk. We request no more security than you feel is adequate to insure the safety of Klansmen and the general public. The Christian Knights of the KKK is dedicated to preserving racial separation, defending states' rights, and remembering the gallant soldiers of the Confederate States of America.

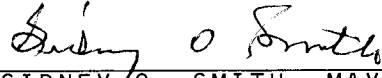
