 OUTSIDE CORPORATE LIMITS

WHEREAS, the City of Petal, Forrest County, Mississippi under the provision of Mississippi Code Annotated § 21-27-1 (1988) et seq. presently owns, operates, and maintains a sewage system/sewage disposal system, or both, for the residents of the City of Petal; and

WHEREAS, the owner of that certain real property located within five (5) miles of and immediately adjacent to the City of Petal, desires to sell said property to a developer who is interested in developing said property as a residential subdivision, said real property being more particularly described as follows:

Tract 1:

A part of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 6, T4N, R12W, Forrest County, Mississippi, and more particularly described as follows:

WHEREAS, the City of Petal is authorized pursuant to Mississippi Code Annotated § 21-27-39 (Supp. 1988) to own, operate, provide and furnish sanitary sewer services to consumers residing outside of and within five (5) miles of the corporate limits of the municipality; and

WHEREAS, in order for the Premises to be serviced by the City of Petal sewer system, construction and permanent easements will need to be obtained, and the City of Petal will need to cooperate fully with the developer in the acquisition of said easements, including but not limited to the acquisition of the following easement:

A Part of the Southeast  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the Southwest  $\frac{1}{4}$  (SE/4 of SW/4) of Section 6 Township 4 North, Range 12 West, in the County of Forrest, State of Mississippi and more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Commence at the Northeast corner of the Northeast  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the Southwest  $\frac{1}{4}$  (NE/4 of the SW/4) of said Section, Township and Range, and runs South along the East line of said Southwest  $\frac{1}{4}$  (SW/4) for a distance of 1,569 feet to and for the point of beginning, thence run North 85°16'W for 239.5 feet, thence run South 4°44'W for 15 feet, thence run North 84°50'W for 30.4 feet, thence South 2°50'E for 15 feet, thence South 84°50'E for 30.4 feet, thence South 85°16'W for 239.5 feet, thence North 30 feet to the point of beginning.

- (2) The City of Petal for providing and furnishing sanitary sewer services to the premises shall charge the owners of any portion of said Premises the standard fees in effect from time to time as the City charges its other customers for sanitary sewer services and connections together with a reasonable fee for any capital improvements or repairs if necessary which arise as a direct result of furnishing sanitary sewer services to the Premises.
- (3) The City of Petal's obligation to provide and furnish sanitary sewer services and/or a sewage disposal system to the above described Premises shall be and is subject to the procurement of the necessary easements running from the Premises to the existing sewer system and the City of Petal herein agrees to cooperate fully in the acquisition of the easements and to accept a dedication or conveyance of said easements when procured by the developer.
- (4) The City of Petal, after all sanitary sewer lines have been constructed and placed in operation on said Premises shall accept a twenty (20) foot permanent easement from the developer to all sewer lines under the streets and across the property excluding that portion of the system which runs from any street to any house or residence constructed on said Premises. All sanitary sewer lines must be constructed in accordance with generally accepted engineering standards, with the City Engineer periodically inspecting and approving said system as it is constructed. After accepting such easement, the City of Petal agrees that it shall be responsible for the

operation and maintenance of all lines as well as for all improvements and repairs to the lines.

- (5) The City of Petal hereby agrees that in the event the necessary easements have not been obtained from the Premises to the existing City sewer lines by September 6, 1990, that the City shall not be obligated to provide sanitary sewer service to the Premises and the developer may develop the Premises using any other sanitary sewer system which he may in sole discretion deem appropriate including but not limited to the use of septic tanks on the Premises.


