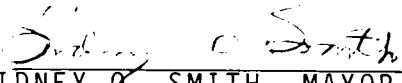

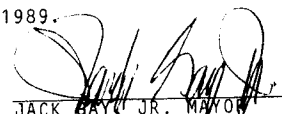

SENIOR CITIZENS meals will be served by the PETAL SCHOOL DISTRICT beginning promptly at 10:30 a.m. on said days and those SENIOR CITIZENS participating will be completed with their meals before student serving time at 11:10 a.m. SENIOR CITIZENS participating will be responsible for picking up their lunch trays at the service line and taking the lunch trays to the dish room window upon completion of their meals.

SENIOR CITIZENS lunch menus will be the same as that served the students of the PETAL SCHOOL DISTRICT. Copies of said menus will appear weekly in the Petal Journal.

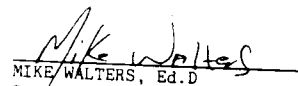
SENIOR CITIZENS participating who wish to bring a guest (grandchildren, children, etc.) will be responsible for paying for said lunches directly to the Food Service Manager. These extra lunches will not be included in the total count for billing the CITY OF PETAL.


The PETAL SCHOOL DISTRICT will submit a monthly billing to the CITY OF PETAL for the total number of SENIOR CITIZENS meals served during the specified month. The rate for reimbursement to the PETAL SCHOOL DISTRICT is set at One Dollar and Seventy-five cents (\$1.75) per SENIOR CITIZEN meal served.

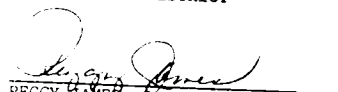
