AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 1986 (65) TO
PROVIDE ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS FOR SECTION 4: BUILDING
SEWERS AND CONNECTIONS AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen of the City of Petal do find, determine and adjudicate that it is reasonable and necessary to amend Ordinance No. 1986 (65) to require under Section 4 of said Ordinance, back-flow preventers when determined to be appropriate and necessary, NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF PETAL, MISSISSIPPI:

SECTION I. That SECTION 4: BUILDING SEWERS AND CONNECTIONS of Ordinance No. 1986 (65), be and the same is hereby amended as follows:

12. Back-flow preventers shall be installed at the cost and expense of the sewer customer, at all new construction deemed necessary and appropriate by representatives of the City of Petal Sewer Department.

SECTION II. Ordinance 1986 (65) except as amended herein, be, and the same is hereby still in full force and effect.

SECTION III. This Ordinance, as amended, be, and the same shall be in full force and effect from and after thirty (30) days from the date of its adoption and approval.

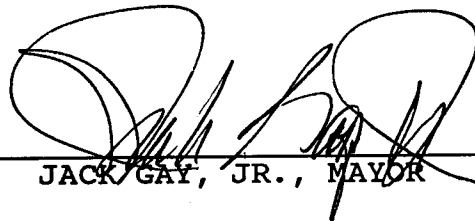

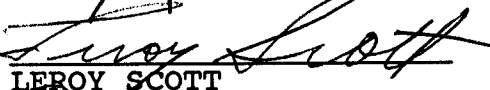
