

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2 OF ORDINANCE 1986 68 B
OF THE CITY OF PETAL, MISSISSIPPI, SO AS TO CHANGE THE
SEWER RATE SCHEDULE FOR THE FOUR MONTHS OF JUNE, JULY,
AUGUST, AND SEPTEMBER OF 1990

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Petal,
Mississippi as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 2 of Ordinance Number 1986 (68) as originally adopted
on November 18, 1989 is hereby amended to read as follows, to wit:

2.2 The sewer rate schedule for the herein named four months; June, July,
August and September, of the summer of 1990 shall be determined by the average
of the past twelve (12) months of billing. This rate schedule change will
cease at the end of September, 1990, and the heretofore used rate schedule,
Section 2.1. will again be effective.

SECTION 2. Validity

2.1 All Ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby
repealed.

2.2. The invalidity of any section, clause, sentence, or provision of this
ordinance shall not affect the validity of any other part of this ordinance
which can be given effect without such invalid part.

SECTION 3. Ordinance in Force

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its
approval and passage.

SECTION 4. Ratification

The above ordinance was first reduced to writing and read and considered
by sections at the regular April 3, 1990, public meeting of the Mayor and
Board of Aldermen and on motion duly made for the adoption of said ordinance


