WHEREAS, MAYOR GAY PRESENTED INFORMATION CONCERNING THE BIDS RECEIVED AT THE JUNE 5, 1990 MEETING FOR THE SELF CONTAINED BREATHING APPARATUS FOR THE FIRE DEPARTMENT. MAYOR GAY STATED THAT TUPELO FIRE EQUIPMENT WAS THE LOWEST BID BUT THE CITY WILL HAVE TO SEND ANY UNITS THAT NEED SERVICE TO THE FACTORY AND THEY WILL NOT PROVIDE REPLACEMENT UNITS DURING REPAIR TIME WHICH WILL LEAVE THE FIRE DEPARTMENT SHORT OF THE EQUIPMENT IN CASE OF A FIRE ALSO TUPELO FIRE EQUIPMENT WILL HAVE FACTORY PERSONNEL TRAIN THE CITY'S FIREMEN UP TO LEVEL 1 IN REPAIR WORK. TUPELO FIRE EQUIPMENT'S BID WAS \$6,609.60 FOR THE SELF CONTAINED BREATHING APPARATUS. MAYOR GAY STATED THAT THE BID FROM SAFETY SALES AND SERVICE WAS \$7,176.54 AND THEY WILL COME TO THE CITY TO DO ALL WARRANTY AND SERVICE WORK THEY WILL ALSO TRAIN THE CITY'S FIREMEN TO LEVEL I AND AN INSTRUCTION TO LEVEL II SERVICE SCHOOL AND THEY WILL PROVIDE REPLACEMENT UNITS FOR ANY UNITS THAT ARE DOWN.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Petal, Mississippi did, on the 20th day of March, 1990, find, determine and adjudicate that certain property belonging to Larry Smith, Conrad Faulkner and Dorothy Faulkner, was in such a state of uncleanness as to be a menace to the public health and safety of the community, said property being located in Forrest County, Mississippi, and being more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Commence at the Northeast Corner of Section 11, Township 4 North, Range 13 West, Forrest County, Mississippi and run South 201.00 feet; thence run West 45.00 feet; thence run South 159.00 feet; thence run South 11 degrees 45 minutes W 219 feet to and for the Point of Beginning. From said Point of Beginning run North 74 degrees 18 minutes W for 150 feet; thence run South 06 degrees 06 feet W for 130.00 feet, thence run North 89 degrees 45 minutes E for 133.00 feet to the West Right of Way line of South Main Street for 91.64 feet back to the Point of Beginning. Said parcel of land being a part of the Northeast Quarter of Section 11, Township 4 North, Range 13 West, Forrest County, Mississippi and contains 0.36 acres, more or less

WHEREAS, prior to the hearing of March 20, 1990, due and proper notice was given to the owners of the property as required by Section 21-19-11 of the Mississippi Code of 1972, as amended, with certified mail notices being given on January 9, 1990, February 10, 1990 and February 23, 1990, as well as publication in the Hattiesburg American, a newspaper having circulation in Petal, Mississippi, being published on February 27, 1990, March 6, 1990 and March 13, 1990, and

WHEREAS, following said determination the Mayor and Board of Aldermen directed and instructed its Street Superintendent, Zollie Stevens, to appropriately clean said property, so that the same would no longer be in such a state of uncleanness as to be a menace to the public health and safety of the community, and

WHEREAS, on this day, the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Petal, Mississippi did receive from said Street Superintendent, Zollie Stevens, a report of the clean-up of said property belonging to Larry Smith, Conrad Faulkner and Dorothy Faulkner, said property being described as set forth herein; and

WHEREAS, there was submitted by Zollie Stevens a daily activity report showing the employees of the City of Petal who

took part in the cleaning of said property, their rate of pay and the number of hours spent on this project, and further presented by Mr. Stevens was a report concerning the equipment used on the clean-up of said property, the fair rental value of said equipment and the hours the equipment was used on said project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ADJUDICATED that the sum of \$2,342.83, as described by that daily activity report presented to the Mayor and Board of Aldermen by Zollie Stevens, Street Superintendent, a true and correct copy of which is attached hereto, be charged the property owners for the cleanup of said property, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that no penalty be assessed as provided by law, but that the sum of \$2,342.83 be assessed as a lien against said described property and that said lien be filed in Forrest County on the Judgment Roll thereof and the Tax Collector of the City of Petal be further directed at the next tax sale to sell said land to satisfy said lien, all as provided and mandated by Section 21-19-11 of the Mississippi Code of 1972, as amended.


