

WHEREAS, MAYOR GAY STATED THAT THE UNSAFE AND UNSANITARY CONDITIONS AT MR SMITH'S PROPERTY AT 213 N GEORGE STREET HAVE BEEN BROUGHT TO THE ATTENTION OF THE BOARD AND AFTER PROPER NOTICE THE HEARING HAS BEEN CALLED. MAYOR GAY STATED THAT THE BUILDING INSPECTOR, DAN TOLBERT HAS STATED THAT MR SMITH HAS STARTED TO CLEAN HIS PROPERTY. THE PROPERTY INVOLVED IS DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:
