WHEREAS, RICHARD ALLEN FLYNT STATED THAT AS A MEMBER OF THE PETAL HIGH SCHOOL BAND BOOSTERS HE HAD CHAPERONED THE BAND TO CHAMBLEE, GEORGIA FOR A CONCERT WITH THE CHAMBLEE BANDS AND THAT ON MAY 11, 1990 THE CHAMBLEE BAND WILL BE COMING TO PETAL FOR A RECIPROCAL CONCERT AND HE WOULD LIKE TO INVITE THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN TO THE CONCERT. 
