WHEREAS, ALDERMAN ROWELL MADE A MOTION THAT THE MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF NOVEMBER 19, 1991 BE ACCEPTED AS WRITTEN. ALDERMAN CLEPPER SECONDED THE MOTION.




