FINAL ORDER GRANTING AND ALLOWING AD VALOREM TAX EXEMPTION

There came on for further consideration and final determination by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Petal, Mississippi, the matter of the Application of Hub City Brush Company for exemption from all ad valorem taxation in the City of Petal, Forrest County, Mississippi within the jurisdiction of the Board of Aldermen and its power to levy, except State and School District Ad Valorem Taxation, as set forth in full in said Application; and the Board of Aldermen having carefully inquired into the matter and maturely considered the same, and being fully advised in the premises, does hereby find, sustain and adjudicate as follows:

THE Board of Aldermen finds that said Applicant has previously filed with it, in due and proper form, an Application for exemption from all ad valorem taxation in the City of Petal, Forrest County, Mississippi within the jurisdiction of the Board of Aldermen and its power to levy, except State and School District Ad Valorem Taxation, upon the tangible property of said Applicant as identified and described in said Application for a period of five (5) years from and after June 28, 1990, with a total true value of \$90,430, and that the Board of Aldermen heretofore on the 19th day of May , A.D., 1992, by Resolution appearing in Municipal Minute Book <u>No. 13</u> at pages 127 , duly passed, adopted, made and entered said appropriate Resolution approving said Application and granting the ad valorem tax exemption therein sought, subject, however, to action of the Mississippi State Tax Commission as provided by law, and directing that appropriate certified transcript or copies of said Application and said Resolution be transmitted to the said Mississippi State Tax Commission for appropriate action by it as provided and required by Sections 27-31-101, et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972, Annotated, and any and all other provisions of law. The Board of Aldermen has now received a letter from the Director of the Property Tax Bureau of said

Mississippi State Tax **Generation** dated April 28, 1992, approving ad valorem tax exemption as applied for by the said Hub City Brush Company and appended and subjoined hereto as a part of this Order and made a part hereof as fully and for all purposes as if set forth at length herein; and it is now appropriate, proper and in the best interest of the City of Petal and all of the parties of interest that action be taken upon said matter and final disposition be made thereof pursuant to all provisions of law.

IT IS, THEREFORE, THE JUDGMENT OF THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN, AND IT IS ACCORDINGLY HEREBY ORDERED, pursuant to the provisions of Sections 27-31-101, et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972, Annotated, and all other provisions of applicable law, that the Application of the said Hub City Brush Company for exemption from all ad valorem taxation in the City of Petal, Forrest County, Mississippi within the jurisdiction of the Board of Aldermen and its power to levy, except State and School District Ad Valorem Taxation, approved by Resolution of the Council in the City of Petal, Minute Book No 13 \_ at pages 127 , and the same being incorporated herein by specific reference thereto, be and the same is hereby, in all respects and in every particular, approved and allowed; and further, that the said Hub City Brush Company be, and is hereby, granted and allowed exemption from all ad valorem taxation in the City of Petal, Forrest County, Mississippi within the jurisdiction of the Board of Aldermen and its power to levy, except State and School District Ad Valorem Taxation, upon all of the tangible property as identified, described and otherwise set forth in said Application hereinabove referred to, all for a term or period of five (5) years commencing on January 15, 1991, for real property and March 1, 1991, for personal property, with a total true value of \$90,430.00.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the <u>Mayor</u> of the City of Petal, be and he is hereby authorized, empowered and directed to record this Order approving such application and granting ad valorem taxation exemption applied for, in the municidal records and to take all other action necessary or required by law to grant said tax exemption herein approved.
