RIVERS STATED THAT HER HUSBAND IS DISABLED AND CANNOT BE TRANSPORTED IN A REGULAR VEHICLE AND THAT THE CITY OF HATTIESBURG HAS BEEN PROVIDING TRANSPORTATION FOR THE HANDICAPPED TO THE DOCTOR AND HOSPITAL WITH A SPECIALLY EQUIPPED BUS THAT HAS A LIFT FOR THE WHEELCHAIR. MRS. RIVERS STATED THAT THIS SERVICE IS NO LONGER AVAILABLE TO PETAL CITIZENS SINCE HATTIESBURG HAS ANNEXED ADDITIONAL AREAS THAT HAVE TO BE PROVIDED THIS SERVICE. MRS. RIVERS REQUESTED THAT THE CITY OF PETAL SEEK FUNDING FOR A SIMILAR SERVICE OR POSSIBLE PAY HATTIESBURG TO PROVIDE THIS SERVICE TO PETAL CITIZENS.



WE BELIEVE THERE ARE ENOUGH JUNK VEHICLES IN PETAL ALREADY AND TO ALLOW THIS APPLICATION WOULD ONLY MAKE THINGS WORSE.

THE CITY HAS MADE SOME PROGRESS RECENTLY AND IS CONTINUING TO MAKE PROGRESS IN REMOVING ILLEGAL AUTOMOTIVE VEHICLES FROM OUR CITY. ANOTHER JUNK CAR OPERATION WOULD BE A STEP BACKWARD.

ALSO, MR. ODOM HAS NOT BEEN CO-OPERATIVE IN THE PAST IN WORKING WITH THE CITY TO GET RID OF MANY JUNK VEHICLES WHICH HE OWNS THAT ARE SCATTERED THROUGHOUT THE CITY. (A) PROHIBIT ENCROACHMENTS, INCLUDING FILL, NEW CONSTRUCTION, SUBSTANTIAL IMPROVEMENTS AND OTHER DEVELOPMENTS UNLESS CERTIFICATION (WITH SUPPORTING TECHNICAL DATA) BY A REGISTERED PROFESSIONAL ENGINEER IS PROVIDED DEMONSTRATING THAT ENCROACHMENTS SHALL NOT RESULT IN ANY INCREASE IN FLOOD LEVELS DURING OCCURRENCE OF THE BASE FLOOD DISCHARGE;

THE ENTRANCES TO OUR CITY ARE PLAGUED WITH UNSITELY AREAS, MOST OF WHICH ARE OLD JUNK VEHICLES AND WE FEEL THAT ALLOWING MORE TO BE BROUGHT IN WOULD ONLY ADD TO THE PROBLEM.


