BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY

SECTION I. That for the year 1993 there shall be and is
hereby levied on all taxable property real and personal within the
corporate limits of the City of Petal, Mississippi, for ad valorem
taxes for municipal purposes as indicated, the following levies to
be collected on each dollar of assessed value shown upon, the real
and personal ad valorem assessment rolls of said City, within the
city limits thereof, to-wit:

FOR GENERAL REVENUE PURPOSES - - - 20.91 MILLS

SECTION II. That for the year 1993, there shall be and there is
hereby levied on all taxable property, real and personal, within the

authorized by the Board of Trustees of said School District by order

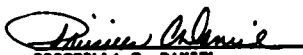
