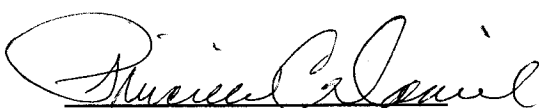

MAYOR JACK GAY OPENED THE HEARING BY STATING THAT THE PROPOSED CHANGES TO THE SUBDIVISION REGULATIONS ORDINANCE 1991 (75) WERE PRESENTED TO THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN BY THE PLANNING COMMISSION AS A RESULT OF THE STUDY OF THE REGULATIONS BY A JOINT COMMITTEE COMPRISED OF MEMBERS FROM THE PLANNING COMMISSION, MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN AND MR. DAN TOLBERT.

MAYOR GAY CALLED FOR ANY PUBLIC COMMENT ON THE PROPOSED CHANGES.

JIM GLADDEN STATED THAT HE REPRESENTS CITIZENS OF PETAL WHO HAVE ASKED HIM TO MAKE A PRESENTATION OF A GENERAL NATURE ON BEHALF OF THE GROUP IN RESPECT TO THE PROPOSED CHANGES TO THE SUBDIVIDING REGULATIONS.

MR. GLADDEN STATED THAT AT THE OUTPUT HE WOULD LIKE TO STATE TO THE ALDERMEN AND MAYOR THAT HE BELIEVES THAT THEY HAVE A VERY FINE ORDINANCE AND REGULATION AS IT IS AND HE DOES NOT SEE WHY THE CITY WOULD WANT TO CHANGE IT AS IT IS QUITE FINE AND WORKABLE AND IS AS GOOD AS ANY IN THE GENERAL REGION AS IT IS.

MR. GLADDEN THEN PROCEEDED TO ADDRESS THE CHANGES AS THEY APPEARED IN THE PUBLIC NOTICE:

1) SECTION 202 SCOPE
SECTION 202.02 - MR. GLADDEN STATED THAT THIS REDEFINES WHAT IS A SUBDIVISION FOR THE CITY OF PETAL. THE GROUP SUPPORTS THIS CHANGE.

2) SECTION 203 DEFINITIONS
SECTION 203.01-16 -

SECTION 203.01.17 SUBDIVISION REVIEW COMMITTEE - MR. GLADDEN STATED THAT HIS GROUP HAS A GREAT DEAL OF PROBLEM WITH THIS PROPOSED AMENDMENT BECAUSE IT LEADS YOU TO BELIEVE THAT SOMEONE OTHER THAN THE PLANNING COMMISSION IS GOING TO BE RESPONSIBLE FOR APPOINTING THIS PLANNING COMMISSION SUBCOMMITTEE. THE PLANNING COMMISSION IS FULLY CAPABLE OF APPOINTING ITS OWN SUBCOMMITTEE. THE GROUP BELIEVES THAT THE LANGUAGE PROPOSED POSES A LOT OF QUESTIONS.

SECTION 300 PREAPPLICATION CONFERENCE

300.01 CHANGE - GROUP BELIEVES THAT THE PREAPPLICATION PROCESS SHOULD BE LEFT AS IT IS.

301.03 GROUP HAS ASKED THE QUESTION "WHY" SHOULD THE WORDS "AND THE ZONING ADMINISTRATOR" BE ADDED SINCE THE ZONING ADMINISTRATOR IS AN INTEGRAL PART OF THE PLANNING PROCESS NOW.

5) 302.02 - LEAVE AS IS

6) SECTION 401 STREETS

401.01-02 - THE GROUP IS VEHEMENTLY OPPOSED TO REDUCING AN OPEN DITCH SYSTEM TO 50 FEET. THIS WILL BE INFERIOR TO THE CURB AND GUTTER.

401.03 GROUP HAS NO PROBLEM WITH THIS PROPOSED CHANGE FROM 35' TO 34'.

AMENDMENT FROM 26' TO 24' - GROUP OPPOSES UNLESS IT IS ADDRESSING THE CURB AND GUTTER SYSTEM IT WOULD CREATE A STREET THAT LESS THAN ADEQUATE.

401.04-01 - CUL-DE-SAC FROM 80' TO 72' - GROUP HAS NO PROBLEM WITH THIS CHANGE IF IT IS DONE IN A CURB AND GUTTER SYSTEM. IF THIS APPLIES TO AN OPEN DITCH SYSTEM, THE GROUP OPPOSES THE CHANGE BECAUSE LARGE TRUCKS WOULD CAUSE DAMAGE TO THE DITCH SYSTEM. MR. GLADDEN STATED THAT HIS GROUP IS CONCERNED THAT SOME OF THE CHANGES WILL TURN AROUND AND MAKE A NEGATIVE SITUATION IF NOT GIVEN FULL CONSIDERATION.

CURB AND GUTTER 27' - ALREADY IN REGULATIONS

7) SECTION 402 MONUMENTS

402.1 - MR GLADDEN STATED THAT THE REGULATIONS AS THEY ARE NOW ARE STANDARD WITH MOST ORDINANCES IN THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, HOWEVER THE PROPOSED CHANGE WHICH LEAVES THIS UP TO THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI AS OUTLINED BY THE MISSISSIPPI STATE BOARD OF REGISTRATION FOR PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERS AND LAND SURVEYORS FOR THE MOST PART LOOKS GOOD, BUT THE CITY HAS ABDICATED ITS DECISION MAKING AUTHORITY FOR SOMETHING THAT MAY CHANGE FROM TIME TO TIME, SO WHY CHANGE IT? THE GROUP THINKS THAT THIS WILL WEAKEN THE REGULATIONS.

402.02 THE GROUP IS AGAINST THE DELETION OF THIS SECTION. THIS IS VERY STANDARD LANGUAGE AND WILL LEAVE THIS REGULATION OPEN TO CHANGE BY SOMEONE OTHER THAN THE BOARD.

CHANGE # 402.03 TO 402.02 - SHOULD LEAVE 402.02 AS IS, THEREFORE THIS WOULD NOT CHANGE.

8) SECTION 406 LOTS

406.02 - MR. GLADDEN STATED THAT BECAUSE OF THE IRREGULARITY IN THE SHAPES OF THE LOTS THAT HIS GROUP BELIEVES THAT THE MINIMUM SETBACK LINE SHOULD BE LEFT AS IS AND THE ONLY CHANGE TO THE SECTION SHOULD BE TO CHANGE THE LOT SIZE BACK TO 6500 SQUARE FEET BECAUSE THAT IS THE MINIMUM LOT SIZE IN THE ZONING ORDINANCE.

9) SECTION 501 VARIANCES

501.01 DELETE ENTIRE PARAGRAPH AND REWRITE
MR. GLADDEN STATED THAT AS IT NOW READS THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN CAN DETERMINE THAT AN EXTRAORDINARY HARDSHIP EXISTS MAY CAUSE SOME PROBLEM WITH THE STRICT COMPLIANCE WITH THE REGULATION, IT MAY VARY UPON

RECOMMENDATION OF THE PLANNING COMMISSION SO THAT SUBSTANTIAL JUSTICE MAY BE DONE, ETC. MR. GLADDEN STATED THAT AS THE AMENDMENT READS THE SAME EXCEPT IT REMOVES THE "IT MAY VARY UPON RECOMMENDATION OF THE PLANNING COMMISSION" WHICH TAKES THE PLANNING COMMISSION OUT OF THE VARIANCE PROCESS AND THAT THE CITY OF PETAL'S ZONING ORDINANCE REQUIRES THAT FOR VARIANCES THE PLANNING COMMISSION BE IN THE PROCESS. MR. GLADDEN STATED THAT HIS GROUP IS VERY CONCERNED ABOUT THIS AMENDMENT AND BELIEVES THAT THE ORDINANCES SHOULD REMAIN CONSISTENT AS FAR AS VARIANCES ARE CONCERNED.

501.02 - MR. GLADDEN STATED THAT THIS TOO WILL DELETE THE PLANNING COMMISSION FROM THE PROCESS OF WHICH IT IS AN INTEGRAL PART. MR. GLADDEN STATED THAT HIS GROUP DOES NOT UNDERSTAND THE REASON FOR THIS PROPOSED AMENDMENT AND IS VERY MUCH OPPOSED TO THIS AMENDMENT.

10) SECTION 503. AMENDMENTS

503.01 MR. GLADDEN STATED THAT HIS GROUP OPPOSES THIS PROPOSES AMENDMENT BECAUSE OF THE LANGUAGE THAT HAS BEEN DELETED "UNLESS IT HAS BEEN PROPOSED OR SUBMITTED TO THE PLANNING COMMISSION". MR GLADDEN STATED THAT IF THIS IS DELETED IT IS GOING TO TAKE THE PLANNING COMMISSION OUT OF THE PROCESS FOR WHICH THEY ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR REVIEWING AND STUDYING SUBDIVISION REGULATIONS AND ZONING ORDINANCES AND MAKING THE RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN. MR. GLADDEN STATED THAT THE LAST SENTENCE IN THE AMENDMENT STATES THAT IF THE PLANNING COMMISSION DOES NOT COMMENT WITHIN THIRTY (30) DAYS A PROPOSED AMENDMENT WILL BECOME LAW; THAT MR. GLADDEN STATED IS INCORRECT AS A PUBLIC HEARING ON ANY AMENDMENT TO THIS ORDINANCE IS REQUIRED PURSUANT TO SECTION 17-1-17 OF THE MISSISSIPPI CODE. MR. GLADDEN STATED THAT THE GROUP HE REPRESENTS OBJECTS TO THIS LANGUAGE BECAUSE IT IMPLIES THAT THIS ORDINANCE WOULD BE AMENDED WITHOUT FOLLOWING THE STATE LAW.

MR. GLADDEN STATED THAT THE GROUP HE REPRESENTS HAS ONE OTHER CONCERN AND THEY ASK THAT HE SPEAK TO THIS CONCERN. THE QUESTION THEY HAVE ASKED IS:

WHY ARE THESE CHANGES BEING PROPOSED WHEN RIGHT NOW YOU HAVE A FINE ORDINANCE AND YOU CAN DEVELOP VERY FINE SUBDIVISIONS BY IT, WHEN IN FACT IT WOULD APPEAR THAT IF SOME OF THESE CHANGES WERE IN PLACE RIGHT NOW, WOULD WIND UP ACCOMMODATING A SUBDIVISION THAT WE HAVE HAD A GREAT DEAL OF DISPUTE OVER; AND WHAT IS THE MOTIVE FOR SOME OF THESE CHANGES.

MR. GLADDEN STATED THAT IN SUMMARY HIS GROUP THINKS THAT THE CITY HAS AN EXCELLENT SUBDIVISION REGULATION AND SHORT OF A MAJOR STUDY OF BOTH THE ZONING ORDINANCE AND THE SUBDIVISION REGULATION TOGETHER TO SEE WHAT CHANGES MIGHT WORK SO THAT THE ORDINANCES REMAIN COMPATIBLE, THEY ARE FEEL THAT THE CITY SHOULD NOT MAKE THESE CHANGES.

MR. GRADY CROSBY STATED THAT HE HAS NOTHING TO ADD BUT HE AGREES WITH EVERYTHING THAT MR. GLADDEN HAS SAID.

MRS. CROSBY STATED THAT SHE DID NOT BELIEVE THAT THESE CHANGES WERE RECOMMENDED BY THE PLANNING COMMISSION OR THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN.

DEBORAH SILLS STATED THAT THE PROPOSED CHANGES ARE VERY COMPLICATED AND THAT SHE IS OPPOSED TO ANY CHANGES UNTIL THERE IS A BETTER UNDERSTANDING OF THE PROPOSED CHANGES.

ED SAULTERS STATED THAT HE DOESN'T SEE A NEED TO CHANGE THE REGULATIONS THIS SOON AFTER ADOPTION.

WILLIAM HORNE STATED THAT HE IS OPPOSED TO ANY CHANGES IN THE STREET REGULATIONS. MR. HORNE STATED THAT IF ANYTHING THE AMENDMENTS SHOULD INCREASE THE SIZE OF THE STREETS NOT MAKE THE STREETS ANY NARROWER.

E. R. (BUDDY) MYRICK STATED THAT THE SUBDIVISION REGULATIONS SHOULD STAY AS ORIGINALLY ADOPTED. MR. MYRICK STATED THAT HE IS A MEMBER OF THE PETAL PLANNING COMMISSION AND THAT HE DOES NOT KNOW OF ANY RECOMMENDATIONS FOR CHANGES TO THE SUBDIVISION REGULATIONS THAT HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE PETAL PLANNING COMMISSION.

AUBRA EVANS STATED THAT THE SOME OF THE ALDERMEN AND PLANNING COMMISSION MEMBERS HAVE BECOME PERSONALLY INVOLVED IN THE SUBDIVISION PROBLEMS AND THEY COULDN'T MAKE A JUDGEMENT IF THEY WANTED TO, IT HAS BECOME PERSONAL TO THEM. MR. EVANS STATED THAT THERE WAS NOT ENOUGH COMMUNICATION BETWEEN THE BOARD AND THE PLANNING COMMISSION. MR. EVANS STATED THAT THINGS WILL NEED TO CHANGE IF THE CITY HAS ANY PLANS FOR ANNEXATION BECAUSE OF THE NEW SUBDIVISIONS THAT ARE DEVELOPING AND WILL DEVELOP IN THE ANNEXATION AREAS. MR. EVANS STATED THAT THERE NEEDS TO BE AN AGREEMENT ON THE SUBDIVISION REGULATIONS AND SETTLE THIS MATTER SO THAT THE CITY CAN MOVE ON.

ALDERMAN RAY BRANDLE STATED THAT HE SERVED ON THE COMMITTEE THAT CONSISTED OF THREE (3) MEMBERS OF THE PLANNING COMMISSION AND TWO (2) ALDERMEN THAT STUDIED THE REGULATIONS AND PRESENTED THE RECOMMENDED CHANGES TO THE PLANNING COMMISSION MEMBERS WHO VOTED TO RECOMMEND THESE CHANGES TO THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN AND, NOW, HE IS HEARING MEMBERS OF THE PLANNING COMMISSION SAY THAT THEY DID NOT RECOMMEND THESE CHANGES AND HE DOESN'T UNDERSTAND.

ROBERT ODOM, MEMBER OF THE PETAL PLANNING COMMISSION, STATED THAT HE DID NOT UNDERSTAND THE CHANGES WHEN THEY WERE FIRST PRESENTED TO THE PLANNING COMMISSION AND THAT NOW HE FEELS THAT THE SUBDIVISION REGULATIONS DO NOT NEED TO BE CHANGED.

EARNEST COLVIN, MEMBER OF THE PETAL PLANNING COMMISSION, STATED THAT HE WAS AT THE JOINT MEETING OF THE PLANNING COMMISSION AND THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN AND THEN AT THE NEXT MEETING OF THE PLANNING COMMISSION A LIST OF CHANGES WERE BROUGHT TO THE MEMBERS FOR REVIEW BY DAN TOLBERT, WHOM MR. COLVIN ASSUMED WAS DELIVERING THE CHANGES FROM THE MAYOR OR MAYBE THE ALDERMEN. MR. COLVIN STATED THAT THE PLANNING COMMISSION DID NOT INITIATE THE CHANGES AND THE CHANGES WERE NOT MADE BY THE PLANNING COMMISSION BUT THEY WERE MADE BY SOMEONE ELSE.

MAYOR GAY CALLED FOR FURTHER COMMENTS. MAYOR GAY ADJOURNED THE HEARING.
