I have been asked to respond to a letter written to Honorable Tom Tyner with regard to the above captioned matter on December 19, 1994. Since that date, Mr. Clearman has conveyed certain lots in Garden Place Subdivision to my client, Bud Sumrall.

Mr. Sumrall is willing to reduce the number of lots remaining around the cul-de-sac area from eight (8) to seven (7); Mr. Sumrall further will agree to amend the restrictive covenants to require a minimum of approximately 1,500 square feet of heated and cooled area in each home, provided that all of the remaining lot owners of Garden Place Subdivision sign the amended restrictive covenants, so that these covenants will be binding upon everyone in the subdivision; that further, Mr. Sumrall agrees to prepare a new plat of the subdivision reflecting the changes necessary to show that the subdivision is amended. Mr. Sumrall's offer is predicated on the City of Petal accepting the street.

Mr. Sumrall will do all of this provided that the City of Petal will grant a variance from compliance with its subdivision regulations and that further, the City of Petal will accept Oliver Lane as a Petal City Street for which the City of Petal will assume all maintenance.
