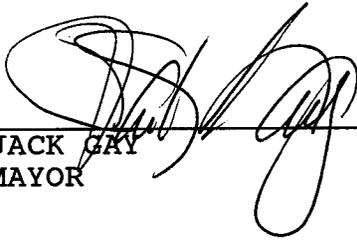

THIS AGREEMENT, DATED September 20, 1995, BETWEEN THE CITY OF PETAL (hereinafter called Client) with offices at 119 West 8th Avenue, Petal, Mississippi 39465 and CREDIT BUREAU OF HATTIESBURG-LAUREL, INC., 810 Hardy Street, Post Office Box 1725, Hattiesburg, Mississippi 39403-1725 (hereinafter called Collector).

IN CONSIDERATION of the mutual agreements and acknowledgements hereinafter made, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. The term of this agreement will commence and continue in force until terminated by either party by written notice as hereinafter provided.

2. With respect to each account or group of accounts forwarded to the Collector for collection, Client will furnish copies of pertinent records showing the total amounts of the unpaid balance, date of charge, and mail return information. Complete identification information on debtor, including social security number or drivers license will be provided.

3. (a) The Collector will devote its reasonably best efforts to recover the full amount of the accounts placed with it for collection through persistent and diligent activity which shall be at all times legal and ethical and in compliance with applicable governmental (Federal, State, and local) rules and regulations including without limitation the Federal Fair Debt Collection Practices Act. In this connection the Collector agrees to indemnify the Client and hold it harmless from any damages or loss whatsoever, arising from any acts or omissions of Collector's agents or employees done in violation of any Federal, State, or local law or regulation while engaging in collections on behalf of Client. The collection activity shall, insofar as practical, maintain the debtor's goodwill toward Client.

(b) Collector agrees to obtain and to maintain in effect any and all licenses and permits required by appropriate governmental authorities with respect to its performance of its obligation as set forth in this agreement.

4. (a) Except as provided in article 6 of this agreement where legal action is filed, Collector shall remit to Client once per month, fees not deducted, together with appropriate statements giving debtor's name, account number and the amount collected on the account.

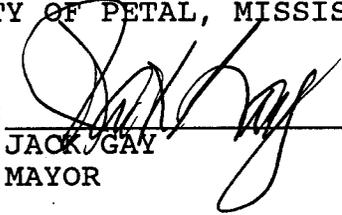

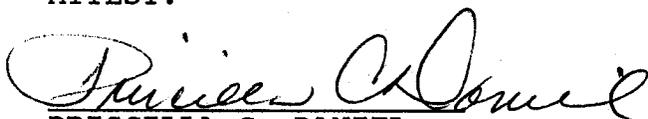
