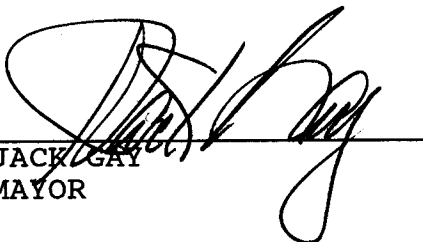

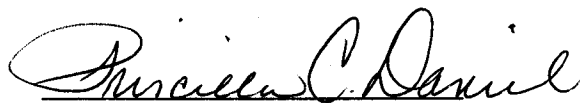

ORDINANCE 1988 (73-G)

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 1988 (73-F), TO PROVIDE FOR ADDITIONAL COMPENSATION FOR THE MAYOR AND THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF PETAL, MISSISSIPPI

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF PETAL, MISSISSIPPI:

SECTION 1: Ordinance 1988 (73-F) is hereby amended as follows, any Ordinances inconsistent with that adopted herein being repealed specifically and by implication:

SECTION 2: **COMPENSATION OF THE MAYOR**

The Mayor of the City of Petal, Mississippi shall be paid compensation for the performance of his official duties at the rate of \$35,000.00 annually.

SECTION 3: **COMPENSATION OF ALDERMEN**

The Aldermen of the City of Petal, Mississippi, shall be paid compensation for the performance of their official duties at the rate of \$7,200.00 annually.

SECTION 4: **EFFECTIVE DATE**

The above and foregoing Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after thirty (30) days from the date of its adoption and approval.

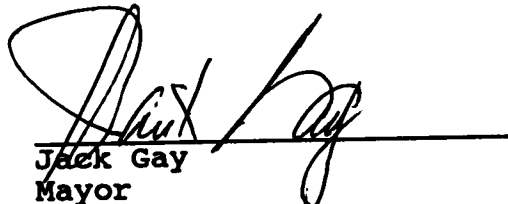

ORDINANCE NUMBER 1984 (57) D  
OF THE CITY OF PETAL, MISSISSIPPI

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 14 (A) OF ORDINANCE 1984 (57) OF THE CITY OF PETAL, MISSISSIPPI, SO AS TO CHANGE THE CHARGES FOR SEWER USE AND TREATMENT WITHIN THE CITY OF PETAL, MISSISSIPPI, REPEALING SECTION 14 (A) OF ORDINANCE NUMBER 1984 (57) AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Petal, Mississippi:

SECTION 1. Section 14 (A) of Ordinance Number 1984 (57) as originally adopted on May 17, 1984 is hereby amended to read as follows, to-wit:

SECTION 14. (A) The following schedule of rates is hereby ascertained, found and declared to be reasonable, and the same are established as the rates to be charged for water subject to minimum charges shown below:

For customers of the Water and Sewer Department of the City of Petal, Mississippi, provided sewer services only, a minimum monthly charge of \$10.00 is hereby imposed.

SECTION 2. All ordinances in conflict herewith be, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force (30) days from and after its passage.

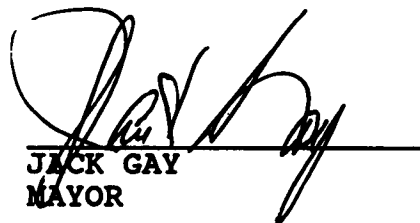

ORDINANCE NO. 1979 (44-I)

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NUMBER 1979(44-H)  
TO AMEND THE AMOUNTS TO BE CHARGED FOR COLLECTION  
AND DISPOSAL OF GARBAGE, TRASH AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF  
THE CITY OF PETAL, MISSISSIPPI:

SECTION 1 of Ordinance 1979(44-H) and other appropriate sections of the  
original ordinance 1979 as amended, are amended to read as follows, to-wit:

SECTION A. The following monthly fees are established for the  
collection, removal, and/or disposal of garbage.

- a. For each residence within the City of Petal, the sum of ten dollars and  
no cents (\$10.00) per month;
- b. For apartment complexes of two or more units, the sum of ten dollars  
and no cents (\$10.00) per apartment, per month;
- c. For all apartment complexes of two or more units not using city  
garbage collection services, the sum of two dollars and no cents (\$2.00) per  
apartment, per month for trash collection services;
- d. For mobile home parks, the sum of ten dollars and no cents (\$10.00)  
per mobile home unit, per month;
- e. For mobile home parks not using city garbage collection services, the  
sum of two dollars and no cents (\$2.00) per mobile home unit, per month for trash  
collection services;
- f. For all other garbage collection customers, the sum of ten dollars and  
no cents (\$10.00) per month provided a garbage pick up is not required to be made  
more than twice in any one week;
- g. All persons who are head of the household, being the sole proprietor  
and only occupant(s) of that residence, and who are over the age of sixty-five, or are  
on disability as determined by either the Veterans Administration or the Social  
Security Administration, or some other agency of the Federal Government, shall  
pay the sum of seven dollars and no cents (\$7.00) per month for the garbage

collection fee established herein, ~~upon proof of~~ <sup>EXHIBIT "D"</sup> said disability or age being properly presented to the Director of the Sanitation Services division, or any other designated employee of the City of Petal, Mississippi;

h. For other collection services, other than residential (home/apartments/mobile home parks) such as businesses, small industry, or those requiring special handling, or more than two collections per week, a fee is to be determined by application of Section 1-12 of Ordinance 1979(44), as amended.

SECTION 2. Section 1-12 is amended to read as follows:

SECTION 1-12. SPECIAL COLLECTION SERVICES

The director may provide for the collection and removal of garbage and rubbish from any place or premises at times in addition to those when regular collection service is provided or in a manner different from the prescribed method of collection.

In the event the director establishes such special service, the director shall have authority to charge the users of such special services a charge based on the division of sanitation services best estimate of their actual cost providing such service, including labor and equipment used.

SECTION 3. That except as otherwise amended herein, Ordinance 1979 and Amendments A, B, C, D, E, F, G and H, shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.

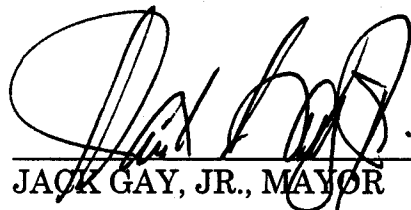

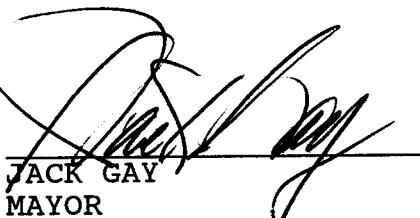
