The Mayor and Board of Aldermen took up for further consideration the matter of the issuance of General Obligation Water and Sewer Refunding Bonds, Series 1999, of the City of Petal, Mississippi, in the principal amount not to exceed Nine Hundred Twenty Five Thousand Dollars (\$925,000), to raise money for the purpose of providing funds for the refunding of all of the City's outstanding Combined Water and Sewer System Revenue Bonds, Series 1989, dated March 15, 1989, issued in the original principal amount of \$700,000, and the advanced refunding of all maturities of the outstanding Combined Water and Sewer Revenue Bonds, dated February 1, 1990, issued in the original principal amount of \$825,000 (together, the "Refunded Bonds"). After a discussion of the subject, Council Member ROWELL offered and moved the adoption of the following resolution:

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE SALE AND AWARD OF GENERAL OBLIGATION WATER AND SEWER REFUNDING BONDS, SERIES 1999 (THE "BONDS"). OF THE CITY OF PETAL, MISSISSIPPI, IN THE PRINCIPAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED NINE HUNDRED TWENTY FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$925,000) TO RAISE MONEY FOR THE PURPOSE OF REFUNDING ALL OF THE CITY'S OUTSTANDING COMBINED WATER AND SEWER REVENUE BONDS, SERIES 1989, DATED MARCH 15, 1989, ISSUED IN THE ORIGINAL PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF \$700,000, AND THE ADVANCED REFUNDING OF ALL MATURITIES OF THE OUTSTANDING COMBINED WATER AND SEWER REVENUE BONDS, DATED FEBRUARY 1, 1990, ISSUED IN THE ORIGINAL PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF \$825,000, AND PAYING THE COSTS OF SUCH BORROWING: AND APPROVING THE FORM OF AND EXECUTION OF AN OFFICIAL FORM OF PROPOSAL FOR THE SALE OF THE BONDS.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Petal, Mississippi (the "Governing Body"), acting for and on behalf of the City of Petal, Mississippi (the "City"), hereby finds, determines, adjudicates and declares as follows:

- 1. The Governing Body did meet at its meeting place in the City Hall in the City of Petal, Mississippi, at 7:00 o'clock A.M. on May 4, 1974.
- 2. Upon receiving the recommendation of Demery Grubbs, representing Holley, Grubbs, Mitcham & Phillips, Jackson, Mississippi, Financial Advisor, and Lucien Bourgeois, representing Butler, Snow, O'Mara, Stevens & Cannada, PLLC, Jackson, Mississippi, Bond Counsel to the City for the Bonds, the Governing Body has determined that they can realize financial benefits with the refunding of the City's outstanding Combined Water and Sewer Refunding Bonds, Series 1989, dated March 15, 1989 (the "Refunded Bonds"), issued in the original principal amount of \$700,000 and the refunding of all maturities of the outstanding Combined Water and Sewer Revenue Bonds, dated February 1, 1990, issued in the original principal amount of \$825,000 (together, the "Refunded Bonds") and hereby desires to authorize the sale of General Obligation Water and Sewer Refunding Bonds, Series 1999, of the City, in an aggregate principal amount of not to exceed Nine Hundred Twenty Five Thousand Dollars (\$925,000) (the "Refunding Bonds").

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BUTLER SNOW ATTY'S

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- 3. The Governing Body has employed Frazier Lanler, Incorporated, Montgomery, Alabama, as underwriter (the "Underwriter"), for the sale of the Bonds. No fee will be due to the Underwriter unless the Governing Body approves the sale and issuance of said Refunding Bonds
- 4. The Governing Body recognizes that the current low interest rate environment provides an opportunity to realize savings from the issuance of Refunding Bonds; and, the Governing Body further realizes that the Governing Body must move expeditiously to accomplish the greatest savings possible by the issuance of the Refunding Bonds. Based on the recommendation of the City's Financial Advisor and Bond Counsel, the Governing Body has determined it needs to anthorize the sale of the Refunding Bonds prior to their next meeting and the Governing Body desires to authorize the Mayor to execute an Official Form of Proposal, the form of which is attached hereto, prior to the next meeting of the Governing Body.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY AS POLLOWS:

- SECTION 1. The Governing Body hereby employs the Underwriters for the sale of the Bonds.
- SECTION 2. The Governing Body hereby approves the form of the Official Form of Proposal (the "Proposal Form") attached hereto.
- SECTION 3. The Governing Body hereby authorizes the Mayor to execute the Proposal Form, acting for and on behalf of the Governing Body, for the issuance of the Refunding Bonds subject to the following conditions: 1) the size of the Refunding Bond Issue will not exceed \$925,000; 2) the net interest cost of the Refunding Bonds will not exceed 4.70%; and 3) the issuance of the Refunding Bonds will result in a \$180,000 gross debt service savings (net of costs) which amount meets or exceeds the 2% net present value savings to maturity requirements of Section 31-27-13, Mississippi Code of 1972, as amended.
- SECTION 4. The Governing Body will adopt the required resolutions and documents required for the issuance and delivery of the Refunding Bonds at a Mayor and Board of Aldermen meeting to be scheduled for a subsequent date.
- SECTION 5. All orders, resolutions or proceedings of this Governing Body in conflict with the provisions of this resolution shall be and are hereby repealed, rescinded and set aside, but only to the extent of such conflict.
- SECTION 6. For cause, this resolution shall become effective immediately upon the adoption thereof.
