RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF PETAL, MISSISSIPPI, PERMANENTLY CLOSING AND VACATING A PORTION OF AN UNNAMED STREET OR ALLEY EXTENDING EASTERLY FROM COCHRAN STREET

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Petal, Mississippi, have been requested by Petition from Petal-Harvey Baptist Church to permanently close and vacate a portion of an unnamed street or alley extending Easterly from Cochran Street more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Commence at the Northeast corner of the Northeast ¼ of the Southeast ¼ of Section 2, Township 4 North, Range 13 West, and run West along the North line of said forty acre tract 435 feet, thence run South 420 feet for a point of beginning, thence run East 170 feet, thence run South 20 feet, thence run West 190 feet, thence run North 20 feet, thence run East 20 feet back to the Point of Beginning:

LESS AND EXCEPT:

The West 70 feet of said parcel which may also be described as the North 20 feet of Lot 1, Block 2, of the Bernie L. Nall Subdivision or Addition of the City of Petal, Forrest County, Mississippi, as per map or plat thereof on file in the Office of the Chancery Clerk.
