ORDINANCE NUMBER 1989 (73-1)
OF THE CITY OF PETAL, MISSISSIPPI

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 1989(73)
AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES

BE IT ORDAINED BY, the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Petal, Mississippi:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 1989(73) is hereby amended to add the following to Section III, to-wit:

When the valuation of the proposed construction exceeds \$1,000.00 and a plan is required to be submitted by 104.2 of the Building Code, a plan-checking fee shall be paid to the building official at the time of submitting plans and specifications for checking. Said plan-checking fee shall be equal to one-half of the building permit fee as set forth in 104.7 of the Building Code. Such plan-checking fee is in addition to the building permit fee.

SECTION 2. Except for the amendment to Ordinance No. 1989(73) contained herein, Ordinance 1989 (73) shall remain in full force and effect 30 days from and after this date.


