

to publish legal notices.



ORDINANCE 1988 (73-K)

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 1988 (73-J), TO
PROVIDE FOR ADDITIONAL COMPENSATION FOR THE
MAYOR AND THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF
PETAL, MISSISSIPPI**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN
OF THE CITY OF PETAL, MISSISSIPPI:

SECTION 1: Ordinance 1988 (73-J) is hereby amended
as follows, any Ordinances inconsistent with that adopted
herein being repealed specifically and by implication:

SECTION 2: COMPENSATION OF THE MAYOR

The Mayor of the City of Petal, Mississippi shall
be paid compensation for the performance of his official
duties at the rate of \$37,700.00 annually.

Section 3: COMPENSATION OF ALDERMEN

The Aldermen of the City of Petal, Mississippi shall
be paid compensation for the performance of their official
duties at the rate of \$8,700.00 annually.

SECTION 4: EFFECTIVE DATE

The above and foregoing Ordinance shall take effect
and be in full force from and after thirty (30) days from
the date of its adoption and approval.
