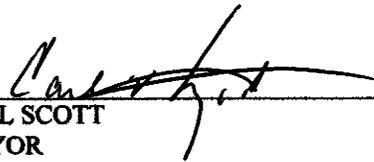

This report is preliminary in nature and is intended to be used for planning purposes only. According to a letter provided by Petal dated January 30, 2006, the USACE has issued a jurisdictional determination that indicates approximately 90% of the site qualifies as federally regulated wetlands. The more detailed delineation report that is being prepared can be provided to the USACE along with an appeal for a reevaluation of the jurisdictional determination. Following reevaluation and issuance of a new jurisdictional determination (if appropriate) by the USACE, Petal will be better able to evaluate specific site plans and layouts for possible wetland impacts and identify measures to avoid and minimize possible impacts. Any activity at the site that would impact potential jurisdictional wetlands and other waters would likely require authorization under the USACE Section 404 and/or Section 10 permitting programs.

Eco-Systems, Inc. (Eco-Systems) is pleased to present the City of Petal (Petal) with this preliminary report of wetlands occurring at the approximately 70-acre proposed park site located along the Leaf River in Petal, Forrest County, Mississippi. On February 24, 2006 Eco-Systems conducted a site visit in order to identify and delineate potential wetlands and "other waters of the U.S." (other waters) potentially subject to U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) regulations that may occur at the subject site. This letter report is intended to provide a preliminary estimation of the aerial extents and location of wetlands and other waters identified at the site.

The site is composed of approximately equal portions of forested area in the eastern portion and open area in the western portion. The majority of the site appears to be composed of what the *Soil Survey of Forrest County* describes as a natural levee formed of silty and sandy soils along stream channels. Signs of previous and extensive disturbances are present at the site including several unreclaimed surface mine pits and associated earthen mounds created by spoil piles or overburden. A railroad right-of-way forms the southern boundary of the site. The railroad is elevated on a constructed berm with drainage ditches along each side, which may have affected natural hydrology by providing effective drainage for much of the site. Two primary categories of potential jurisdictional wetlands were found to occur at the site. The first category is wetlands and includes areas that meet the criteria set forth in the *United States Army Corps of Engineers Wetlands Delineation Manual Technical Report Y-87-1*. Potential jurisdictional wetland areas observed at the site are associated with floodplain depressions that wind across the site. The second category is other waters and includes ponds created by prior surface mining operations as well as the channel of the Leaf River, which forms the western site boundary. A preliminary estimate of the extent of wetlands on the site indicates that approximately 1/4 of the site contains potential jurisdictional wetlands. A final and more detailed delineation report and wetland boundary figure will be provided as soon as the necessary data processing and quality assurance reviews are completed.

In summary, it is our opinion that the development of the site as a recreational area to include low-impact type activities such as soccer fields, nature trails, etc. is feasible and could potentially be done in a way that minimizes the impacts to any existing jurisdictional wetlands and could potentially reduce mitigation efforts.
