Dear Mayor Scott:

I am writing to you in regard to multiple lift stations in the City of Petal. Shows, Dearman and Waits, Inc. conducted inspections of all the lift stations in Petal, but I would like to address five (5) of the locations here:

Main Lift Station at The River – the station is the only pump station out of the City and to the treatment facility across the Leaf River. Upon inspection only one (1) of the four (4) pumps in this station was operational. Loss of this station would be catastrophic.

West 7th & Short South Street – this is a large lift station in which only one pump is operational. The operational pump is not pumping at capacity and must be watched carefully.

North George & West Cherry Street – upon inspection had only one pump operational and has since had to be bypassed with an external pump.

Marylynn Drive & Old Richton Road – this station has only one pump operational and that pump is requiring excess amperage to operate. Public works has spent a great deal of time dealing with the failure of this station.

Old Richton Road & Bryant Street – had only one pump operational upon inspection and are pulling excess amperage to operate. Since the inspection this station has been bypassed externally.

It is my opinion that these five (5) lift stations present an immediate and emergent situation for the City of Petal. Therefore, I recommend that emergency action be taken by the Board of Alderman so that quotes may be taken to immediately repair theses locations.

MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT RESOLUTION OF AUTHORIZATION

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen (the "Governing Body") acting for and on behalf of the City of Petal, Mississippi, (the "Municipality") took up for consideration the matter of authorizing and approving grant on behalf of the Municipality from the Mississippi Developmen Authority (the "MDA") for the purpose of Constructing infrastructure related to a high tech industrial park and thus enhancing economic development through the creation of jobs.

Thereupon, Alderman $\underline{\text{Fairley}}$ offered and moved the adoption of the following:

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF PETAL, MISSISSIPPI, TO AUTHORIZE AND APPROVE THE MAYOR ON BEHALF OF THE CITY, ENTERING INTO A GRANT ACREEMENT WITH THE MISSISSIPPI DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY IN ORDER TO RECEIVE A GRANT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY FROM THE MISSISSIPPI DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED ONE HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (S150,00,000) FOR THE PURPOSE OF THE CONSTRUCTION OF INFRASTRUCTURE RELATED TO A HIGH TECH INDUSTRIAL PARK AND THUS ENHANCING ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT THROUGH THE CREATION OF JOBS.

WHEREAS, the Advantage Mississippi Initiative Senate Bill 2002, 2nd Extraordina Session 2000 created a special fund in the State Treasury call the "Small Municipalities and Limited Population Counties Fund". The Mississippi Development Authority ("MDA") has established a grant program for grants to small municipalities and limited population countinatural gas districts created by law and contained therein to assist in completing projects, an

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 57-1-18 of the MS Code of 1972 (the "ACT") the Small Municipalities and Limited Population Counties Program, MDA is authorized to make a grant to the County for the purpose of Constructing Infrastructure related to a high tech industrial park and thus enhancing economic development through the creation of jobs; and ultimately enhancing the quality of life in order to attract additional industry and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Act and the guidelines adopted by MDA, the Municipality has filed an application with MDA for a grant to Constructing Infrastructure related to a high tech industrial park; and

WHEREAS, based on the application, the Act and the guidelines, MDA has agreed to a grant to the municipality for the purposes set forth; and

WHEREAS, before the grant can be processed, a Grant Agreement must the entered into by the Municipality and MDA, setting out the terms and conditions of the grant.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE MUNICIPALITY, AS FOLLOWS.

Section 1. That all of the findings of fact made and set forth in the preamble to this resolution shall be and the same are hereby found, declared, and adjudicated to be true and correct.

Section 2. That the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Petal, Mississippi, is now fully authorized and empowered under the provisions of Section 57-1-18, of the Mississippi Code of 1972, to proceed with the execution of the Grant Agreement with the Department.

Section 3. That the Mayor and Clerk of the Board area hereby authorized and directed to execute any and all documents and certificates as may be nece4ssary in order to consummate the transaction contemplated by the resolution and upon execution, each of the documents and certificates shall be legal, valid, and binding obligations of the Municipality enforceable in accordance to the terms of each.

Alderman <u>Weaver</u> seconded the motion to adopt the foregoing Resolution and after the same had been read and considered section by section and put to a roll call vote, the results was as follows:
