BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF PETAL, MISSISSIPPI:

SECTION 1. That the Comprehensive Zoning District Map, adopted as part of the Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance Number 1979 (42) of the City of Petal, Mississippi, as amended by Ordinance Numbers 1979 (42-1) through 1979 (42-A182) and the same is hereby changed and amended as per petition filed in connection therewith so that the land described as listed below. Based on our conversation of Friday, September 8, 2006, this letter is a request for an agreement between City of Petal and Kathy and I in regards to our property located at 198 Trussell Road, Petal Mississippi.
