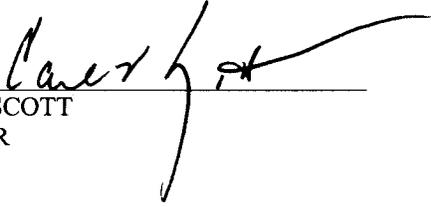

Animal control amendment

Section 4-3-3 Subsection A

It shall be unlawful for any person to keep or maintain within the corp. limits of the City of Petal, any vicious, ferocious or dangerous animal or fowl or any such animal exhibiting such traits which has the ability to do bodily harm or injury to any person, other animal or fowl.

Section 2-1 Subsection R.

Any person leaving any animal or fowl unattended for a period exceeding 48 hours shall be guilty of "Neglect" and guilty of a misdemeanor.

Section 2-1 Subsection Q

No person shall house no more than six animals or fowl over the age of 6 (six) months at a single residence.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Petal, Mississippi, are now fully authorized to enact an ordinance for such purposes under the authority of Section 21-19-25 of the Mississippi Code of 1972, Annotated as Recompiled, and other sections of said code;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Petal, Mississippi:

SECTION 1: That the International Building Code (2003 authorized edition with amendments) and any subsequent revisions, a copy of which has this day been exhibited to and approved by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Petal, Mississippi, be and the same is hereby adopted and declared operative as of the first day of November, 2006, and binding within the corporate limits of the City of Petal, Mississippi, and the police jurisdiction thereof.

SECTION 2: That the said International Building Code (2003 authorized edition, with amendments) is too voluminous to here set out in full, but copies of the same are on file with the Clerk of the City of Petal, and are made a part of this ordinance as if fully and completely copied and set forth herein.

ORDINANCE NO 2006

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE 2006 INTERNATIONAL PROPERTY MAINTENANCE CODE, PROVIDING FOR ENFORCEMENT GUIDELINES AND PENALTIES, AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES; ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE FOR SAID ORDINANCE, AND REPEALING PREVIOUS ORDINANCES, AND THOSE IN CONFLICT HEREWITH

BE IT ORDAINED BY, the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Petal, Mississippi, that the 2006 International Property Maintenance Code is adopted by the City of Petal, Mississippi, so as to regulate and govern the conditions and maintenance of all property, buildings and structures; by providing the standards for supplied utilities and facilities and other physical things and conditions essential to ensure that structures are safe, sanitary and fit for occupation and use; and the condemnation of buildings and structures unfit for human occupancy and use, and the demolition of such existing structures in the City of Petal providing for the issuance of permits and collection of fees therefore; repealing Ordinance No. 2000 of the City of Petal and all other ordinances and parts of the ordinances in conflict therewith.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Petal, Mississippi:

SECTION 1. That a certain document, three (3) copies of which are on file in the office of the City Clerk of the City of Petal, being marked and designated as the International Property Maintenance Code, 2006 edition, as published by the International Code Council, be and is hereby adopted as the Property Maintenance Code of the City of Petal in the State of Mississippi for regulating and governing the conditions and maintenance of all property, buildings and structures; by providing the standards for supplied utilities and facilities and other physical things and conditions essential to ensure that structures are safe, sanitary and fit for occupation and use; and the condemnation of buildings and structures unfit for human occupancy and use, and the demolition of such existing structures as herein provided; providing for the issuance of permits and collection of fees therefore; and each and all of the regulations, provisions, penalties, conditions and terms of said Property Maintenance Code on file in the office of the Code Enforcement Office are hereby referred to, adopted, and made a part hereof, as if fully

set out in the ordinance, with the additions, insertions, deletions and changes, if any, prescribed in Section 2 of this ordinance.

SECTION 2. To insure compliance with the provisions of 2006 International Property Maintenance Code, the following enforcement guidelines are established:

- A. Section 101.1. City of Petal.
- B. Section 103.5. The fees for inspections shall be \$35.00 for the first inspection and \$25.00 for each follow-up inspection.
- C. Section 302.4. Ten (10) inches.
- D. Section 304.14. July 1 to October 7.
- E. Section 602.3. September 1 to April 1.
- F. Section 602.4. September 1 to April 1.

SECTION 3. That Ordinance No. 2000-1 and all other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. That if any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is, for any reason, held to be unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance. The State of Mississippi, hereby declares that it would have passed this ordinance, and each section, subsection, clause or phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses and phrases be declared unconstitutional.

SECTION 5. That nothing in this ordinance or in the 2006 Property Maintenance Code hereby adopted shall be construed to affect any suit or proceeding impending in any court, or any rights acquired, or liability incurred, or any cause or causes of action required or existing, under any act or ordinance hereby repealed as cited in Section 3 of this ordinance; nor shall any just or legal right or remedy of any character be lost, impaired or affected by this ordinance.

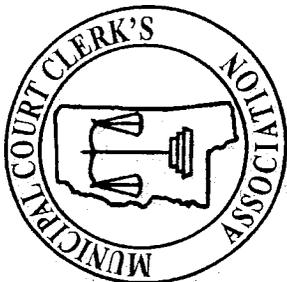
