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AN ORDINANCE CHANGING AND AMENDING THE COMPREHENSIVE ZONING ORDINANCE NO. 1979 (42) OF THE CITY OF PETAL, MISSISSIPPI

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY

OF PETAL, MISSISSIPPI

- SECTION 1: The following articles of Ordinance 1979(42) be amended as follows
- 7.41 In the case of new and or used car dealers, not more than 10 wrocked vehicles used for parts or to be rebuilt, may be kept on the dealers for provided that they are behind the principle building used for sales and totally out of the public view. Any question as to what constitutes out of the public view shall be determined by the City Planning Commission and approved by the Board of Aldermen. The utent of this section is to prohibit new and or used car dealers from becoming or appearing to become a junk yard as defined in section 5.36 of this ordinance.
- 7.41.1 Automobile Repair, Automobile Washes and Collision and Bump Shops shall be subject to the following requirements:

 - to the following requirements:
 Such uses shall have a minimum frontage along the principle street of one hundred-fifty (150) feet, and a minimum area of fifteen thousand (15,000) square feet.
 Separation shall be made between the pedestrian aldewalk and vehicular parking and maneuvering areas with the use of curbs, greenbelts and or tarffic talands.
 Drive ways shall be designed to accommodate the type and volume of vehicular parking and maneuvering areas with the use of curbs, greenbelts and or tarffic talands.

No driveway or curb opening shall be located nearer than thirty (30) feet to any other driveway service way shall be located nearer than thirty, (30) feet to on yother driveway services all or service area of the factity, shall be probable dots enter the hours of 10.00 pm and 8.00 a.m. No junk, debris, abarkoned or dismaniled automobile per mdoor stall consist of a solid masony-screening device except for gates, and subting properties and public streets. No person shall park a vehicle upon private property belonging to another for the principal purpose of displaying such vehicle for sale. It shall be unlawful for the owner of any property located within the city to allow vehicles owned by others to be parked on such property for the principal purpose of being offered for sale.

Whenever a parked vehicle displays a sign or message indicating that it is being offered for sale, such display shall be prima facie evidence that the vehicle is parked for the primapil purpose of being displayed for sale. For purposes of this section, the term "vehicle" shall include any device capable of being moved from place to place upon wheels or tracks, as well as devices capable of being moved on or through water or air, such as boats and arphanes.
