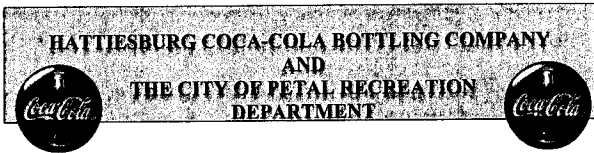

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING AND AMENDING THE COMPREHENSIVE ZONING ORDINANCE NO. 1979 (42) OF THE CITY OF PETAL, MISSISSIPPI, AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NUMBERS 1979 (42-1) THROUGH 1979 (42-A192) SO AS TO CHANGE THE ZONING CLASSIFICATION OF PROPERTY LOCATED AT 749 HIGHWAY 42, PETAL, MS, FROM R-1 (LOW DENSITY RESIDENTIAL) TO C-1 (NEIGHBORHOOD COMMERCIAL DISTRICT)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF PETAL, MISSISSIPPI:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 2007 (1)

AN ORDINANCE TO ALLOW CERTAIN SECTIONS OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF PETAL, MISSISSIPPI TO BE PENALIZED BY ISSUANCE OF NOTICES OF VIOLATION AND/OR A MUNICIPAL OFFENSE TICKET, AND TO ESTABLISH THE WAY CERTAIN AUTHORIZED CITY EMPLOYEES ISSUE MUNICIPAL OFFENSE TICKETS

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Alderman of the City of Petal, Mississippi, desire to improve the safety, health and general welfare of the city; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of this ordinance is to allow certain laws and sections of the Code of Ordinances to be enforced by issuance of a municipal offense ticket; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Alderman of the City of Petal deem it appropriate and necessary to establish a schedule of fines of said offense, and authorize certain City employees to issue municipal offense tickets, and

WHEREAS, to provide an efficient and effective process by which complaints concerning unclean properties, dilapidated structures, and other City Code violations can be resolved in an expedient and efficient manner;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Board of Alderman of the City of Petal, Mississippi:

Section 1. Definitions

For the purpose of this ordinance, the following definitions shall apply:

1. "City" shall mean the City of Petal, Mississippi.
2. "Officer" shall mean the duly authorized Building Inspector, Code Enforcement Officer, his/her duly authorized deputies or other properly designated City employees as may be provided by any one or more chapters covered by this Ordinance.
3. "Notice of Violation" shall mean the official notification of the violation to the violator.
4. "Municipal Offense Ticket" shall mean the complaint and citation form issued to violator of the Code.

Section 2. Purpose

The purpose of this ordinance is to allow certain laws and sections of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Petal, Mississippi, to be penalized by issuance of a notice of violation or a municipal offense ticket, to establish a schedule of fines for said offenses, and to authorize certain city employees to issue notice of violation or municipal offense tickets. The process and procedure set forth in this ordinance shall be supplemental to and not to the exclusion of any and all ordinances of the City or applicable laws of the State of Mississippi.

- a. Municipal Court Process: Municipal Court to abate violations as referred to in this document.
- b. Lien Process: This process involves the tearing down of dilapidated buildings or structures and/or cleaning of property as provided for in Section 21-19-11, MS Code of 1972.

1. If the matter should be pursued in Municipal Court, then the process outlined below shall be followed; however, if it is appropriate to use the Lien Process, then the public hearing process by the Board of Alderman should be followed, as provided for in Section 21-19-11, MS Code of 1972.

3. Procedure for Filing Complaints in Municipal Court:

- a. Once a violation has been confirmed and a determination has been made to proceed in Municipal Court, then the Officer shall complete the Municipal Offense Ticket Complaint and Citation Form.
- b. The complaint shall cite the section(s) of the law being violated and generally describe the violation through the use of a check list.
- c. The Officer shall complete the Municipal Offense Ticket Complaint and Citation form, and using the court date pre-determined by the Municipal Court Judge when delivering the Complaint and Citation form to the defendant.
- d. The Officer shall deliver the Complaint and Citation form to the violator by one of the following means:
- e. Personally deliver
- f. Posting
- g. By Certified Mail
- h. (If posting, by leaving a copy on their door, must also send a copy certified mail)
- i. Time and date stamped photographs showing the violation still exists are to be placed in the file. The time and date that the Complaint and Citation is delivered must be documented in the case file and a copy of the delivered document must be retained in the case file.

4. Municipal Court- Code Enforcement Division:

- a. The Municipal Judge will be responsible for establishing a specific day or days each month on which dilapidated structures, unclean properties and/or code violation cases will be heard. This has been determined to be the first Tuesday of each month at 1:30 PM.
- b. One the hearing date, the Officer will appear in court with the following items:
- c. Case Files
- d. Initial and Current Photographs
- e. Appropriate Documentation

5. Methods of Enforcement in Municipal Court of Code Violations

- a. The Court may deal with each defendant in accordance with one of the following procedures:
 - i. Delay Disposition
When the defendant appears in Court, the judge may delay disposition of the case in order to give the defendant time to clear the problem by a certain date and that a defendant appears in court on that date. Property is to be inspected immediately before that date to see if the problem has been resolved; if so, the charge will be dismissed without costs or penalty. If not resolved, the judge will take a plea and set a trial, if necessary, if there is a conviction, handle as below:
 - ii. Take a Plea
Compel the defendant to appear in court by warrant or citation, the judge will take a plea.
 1. If the defendant pleads guilty or is found guilty after a not guilty plea, a fine and court costs will be assessed.
 2. The judge may suspend the fine (cannot suspend court costs) on condition that the problem be cleared by a given date, after which property will be inspected. If violations is abated, no further action is necessary. If not abated, a

The goals of this ordinance are:

1. To promote livability for the residents of the neighborhoods of the City of Petal;
2. To improve the quality of life of all residents;
3. To encourage adherence to the laws and codes of the City of Petal; and
4. To provide for the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the City of Petal, Mississippi

Section 4. Objective

To provide an efficient and effective process by which complaints concerning dilapidated structures, unclean properties and other code violations may be resolved in an expedient and efficient manner.

Section 5. Procedure

The following procedure shall be adhered to:

1. Complaints
 - a. All complaints regarding dilapidated structures, unclean properties, and/or code violations will be directed to the City of Petal Code Enforcement Office and where applicable to the provisions of this ordinance, distributed to the Building Inspector or otherwise distributed to appropriate City departments for handling.
 - b. The Petal Code Enforcement staff will be responsible for recording and documenting all complaints.
2. Inspections
 - a. The Code Enforcement Officer will be responsible for making an initial inspection after notification by the Code Enforcement Office, and for making a determination regarding the validity of the complaint.
 - b. If the suspected violation involves an area outside the Code Enforcement Officer's designated area of expertise, the Officer shall return the notification to the Code Enforcement Office for them to record and forward to the appropriate City department for handling.
 - c. If there appears to be a violation, the Code Enforcement Officer will document the violation and deliver an official Notice of Violation to the violators by one of the following means:
 - d. Personally deliver
 - e. Posting
 - f. By Certified Mail
 - g. (If posting, by leaving a copy on their door, must also send a copy certified mail)
 - h. A copy of the notice of violation will be kept at the Code Enforcement Office for follow-up and action. The Code Enforcement Office will be responsible for maintaining accurate and complete records of each violation received from the Officers.
 - i. The Code Enforcement Officer shall be responsible for establishing a case file that is designated by a case number, shall make a determination relative to who should be charged with the violation, and provide time and date stamped photographs of the violation.
 - j. On the date designated in the notice of violation for reinspection, the Officer will be responsible for inspecting the violation to determine if it has been corrected. If the violation has been abated, it will be noted resolved on the reverse side of the Notice of Violation and returned to the Code Enforcement Office for file closing.
 - k. If the violation is not abated, then, based upon the offense, the violation may be pursued by the Officer through the Municipal Court or through the Lien Process provided for in Section 21-19-11, MS Code of 1972, as follows:

warrant will be issued compelling the defendant to appear before the court to determine if the suspension should be revoked and defendant be required to pay the suspended fine.

- iii. Take a Plea
Compel the defendant to appear in court by warrant or citation. When defendant appears, the judge will take a plea.
 1. If defendant pleads guilty or is found guilty after a not guilty plea, the judge will impose a sentence of a fine and costs and order the defendant jailed. Either or both the fine and jail may be suspended and handled as above or defendant may be immediately placed in jail and ordered to pay the fine and costs.
 2. Any conviction in the Municipal Court may be appealed to the County Court for a new trial. City staff will be present cases before a county judge with a court reporter present.
 3. The Municipal Court Clerk shall provide a copy of the Court's determination to the Officer following each court date.
 4. The Officer is responsible for ensuring that future Court dates are noted and that required photographs will be available to the Court on the date of a defendant's required re-appearance.

Section 6. Ordinances and Technical Codes

- a. The City had numerous laws that are applicable to the goals and objectives of Property Court.
- b. However, the three primary laws that will be used to achieve these goals and objectives are the International Property Maintenance Code, Standard Housing Code and the Code of Ordinances of the City of Petal, Mississippi. Citations of the preceding laws and schedule of fines are attached as Exhibit A.

Section 7. Court Orders

The following Court Orders shall be adopted and entered by the Municipal Court necessary to implement the process and procedures set forth by the ordinance:

ORDER

The Court finds and determines that there is a need to establish a Code Enforcement Division of this Court and to adopt rules therefore. Therefore, It is ordered:

- a. That there is hereby established a Code Enforcement Division of the Municipal Court to deal with cases involving violations of the City of Petal Code of Ordinances, any technical codes adopted by the City; other laws prohibiting persons from maintaining their property in an unsightly, unsafe, or unsanitary condition; and all other laws regulating real property in the City.
- b. That complaints filed within the Code Enforcement Division will be identified by the letter "E" preceding each case number.
- c. That complaints filed within the Code Enforcement Division shall have sequential numbers which shall be different from traffic complaints, implied consent complaints, or general complaints.
- d. That the cases with the Code Enforcement Division shall be set for hearing at --- on the --- of each month in the courtroom of the Municipal Court at --- Dated the --- day of ---, A.D., 2007.
