AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE BURIAL OF THE REMAINS OF HUMAN BODIES OUTSIDE THE CONFINES OF A CEMETERY ORGANIZATION AS DEFINED IN 41-43-31 THROUGH 41-43-53 OF THE MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, AS AMENDED; AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF

SECTION 1.

Within the municipal limits of the City of Petal, Mississippi, no person, partnership, corporation, or other legal entity shall bury or dispose of the remains of human bodies except in a designated cemetery as contemplated by 41-43-31 through 41-43-53 of the Mississippi Code of 1972, as amended.

SECTION 2.

Any person, corporation, partnership, or other legal entity violating the provision of this Ordinance shall be subject to a fine no to exceed one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) and or by imprisonment not to exceed thirty (30) days.
