



AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 14(A) OF ORDINANCE 1984(57)
OF THE CITY OF PETAL, MISSISSIPPI, SO AS TO CHANGE THE
CHARGES OF WATER AND SEWER USE WITHIN THE CITY OF PETAL,
MISSISSIPPI, REPEALING PART OF SECTION 14(A)
OF ORDINANCE NUMBER 1984(57) AND
FOR RELATED PURPOSES

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Petal,

Mississippi:

SECTION 1. Section 14(A) of Ordinance Number 1984(57) as originally adopted on May 17, 1984 is hereby amended to read as follows. To-wit:

SECTION 14: Schedule of rates.

(A). The following schedule of rates is hereby ascertained, found nd declared to be reasonable, and the same are established as the rates to be charged for water subject to minimum charges shown below:

RESOLUTION CITY OF PETAL

WHEREAS, the City of Petal has requested assistance from the Community Services Division of the Mississippi Development Authority under the Community Development Block Grant Program to assist in the construction of a new sewer collection system in a currently unserved area of the city; and

WHEREAS, the Mississippi Development Authority requires that the City of Petal submit a maintenance plan concerning the proposed sewer collection system construction and adopt a resolution detailing the city's responsibility in maintaining the proposed system; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Petal commits to:

- 1) Maintain the proposed sewer collection system for the life of the system.
- 2) Assign the Water and Sewer Department as the City personnel to be responsible for the maintenance of the proposed sewer collection system.
- 3) Use a portion of the water and sewer fees to establish a maintenance fund for the proposed improvements.
- 4) Set aside \$5,000 annually from the water and sewer fees for the purpose of maintaining the proposed sewer collection system until the fund reaches a balance deemed appropriate for perpetually maintaining the system.
- 5) Acknowledge that a failure to maintain the funded improvements will affect future Community Development Block Grant funding.
