# Standard Operating Procedure for Field Training Officers. EXHIBIT "B"

The purpose of this procedure is to adopt a policy for the training of new and lateral police officers within the Petal Police Department.

The purpose of the field training program is to standardize the training that all newly hired police officers receive within the police department. The program will consist of three phases, with each phase lasting three weeks. Lateral officers will be required to attend one three week phase. All trainees will be required to receive training in all the specified areas covered in this policy. Field Training Officers (F.T.O.) will be required to provide proficiency and conduct reports on all trainees upon completion of each phase of training. Proficiency and conduct reports are to be turned in to the fto coordinator for evaluation of training and approval by the administration for advancement to the next phase of training.

F.T.O.s will attend regularly scheduled meetings established by the fto coordinator and the training supervisor. The purpose of the meetings will be to evaluate the training program and suggest changes to be implemented to the training program. All changes suggested must be accepted and approved by the administration prior to being added to the program.

Phase one of the program will consist of training in the following:

1. Trainees will observe the operations of each division within the department.
  - A. Field training officers will ensure that all subject matter is covered and will be required to sign off on the training. The trainee will also be required to initial next to the covered material on the field training report. The division commander or representative of the division commander will be required to sign the bottom of the field training report.

Phase one:

1. Dispatch:
 

During this phase the trainee will observe the daily or nightly observations of the dispatcher. The trainee should develop an understanding of dispatch. Also while in dispatch the trainee will receive instructions from the dispatch supervisor on how nrc works, rms computer system, 911 phone system, and call rotation.
2. Court Clerk:

- F. City ordinances.
- G. Response to domestic situations.
- H. Booking checks and response to alarms.
- I. Heavy traffic stops.

During the training phase emphasis should be on officer safety.

Upon the completion and evaluation of phase one training the F.T.O. will make a request for the trainee to advance to phase two of the training.

Phase two of the program will consist of the trainee participating, to the point the F.T.O. determines necessary, in all regular police functions. During this phase the trainee should exhibit gradual improvement in interpersonal communication, proficiency with reports and ticket writing, and should have a basic understanding of the police department operations.

F.T.O.s will be responsible for reporting to the F.T.O. coordinator and training supervisor through conduct and proficiency reports on the progress, or lack thereof, with the trainee. F.T.O.s should ensure that the trainee is exposed to as many situations as possible during this phase. Situations can be simulated through training or through actual calls for service.

Phase three of the training will consist of the F.T.O. observing the trainee. During this phase the trainee should perform all duties under the direct supervision of the F.T.O. Upon completion the F.T.O. will submit a final conduct and proficiency report to the F.T.O. coordinator and training coordinator. The conduct and proficiency report will advise as to whether or not the trainee has satisfactorily completed all phases of training. The report will be reviewed by the F.T.O. coordinator and training coordinator and be submitted to the administration for final approval. Upon final approval by the administration the trainee will be released to full active duty.

Lateral officers will be required to pass a three week phase of training. The amount of time spent within a phase of training shall be determined by the Field Training Officer. Field Training Officers may submit a conduct and proficiency report advising that a particular trainee has satisfactorily completed all required fields of training. Upon approval by the administration the trainee may be placed on duty without further training.

The purpose of the lateral training program is to ensure that all lateral transfers from other agencies develop an understanding of how the petal police department operates. Field Training Officers should incorporate primarily phase one into the lateral training phase.

During this phase the trainee will receive instruction on and observe the operations of the court clerk and warrants division. The trainee will receive instructions on warrants, subpoenas, and subpoenas for court. Also the trainee will learn about court procedure including the prosecution of offenders and dismissal of charges.

### 3. Criminal Investigation Division:

During this phase of training the trainee will receive instruction from detectives on subject matter including but not limited to:

- A. Information for reports such as suspect information, times, dates, victims, etc.
- B. Chain of custody paperwork including how to fill out evidence forms, and placement of evidence into the evidence locker.
- C. Crime scene documentation and the preservation of evidence at a crime scene. Also crime scene preservation and crime scene log paperwork.
- D. Initial response to crime scenes determined by the commander of the criminal investigation division.
- E. Basic photography of crime scenes, including but not limited to the use of camera's, printing of photographs.

### 4. Vice Narcotics Division:

During this phase of training the trainee will receive information and instruction on subject matter including but not limited to:

- A. Detection and observation of possible narcotic activity.
- B. Identification of narcotics.
- C. Search and seizure covering the 4<sup>th</sup> amendment.
- D. Officer safety pertaining to the handling of hazardous narcotics.
- E. Establishment of contact information for narcotics investigators.
- F. Collection of narcotics evidence.

### 5. Patrol Division:

During this phase of training the trainee will receive instruction on basic patrol operations including but not limited to:

- A. Paper work associated with the patrol division.
- B. Stop and approach of vehicles and suspicious subjects.
- C. The booking process.
- D. Ticket writing, post arrests, and affidavits.
- E. Department policies pertaining to pursuits and use of force.





