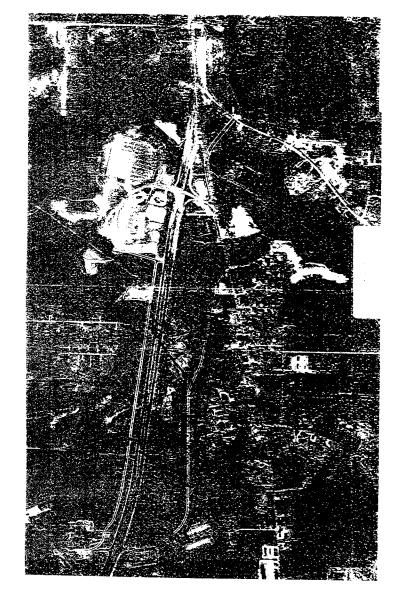

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Standard Operating Procedure for EXHIBIT "B" Field Training Officers.

The purpose of this procedure is to adopt a policy for the training of new and lateral police officers within the Petal Police Department.

The purpose of the held training program is to standardize the training that all newly hired police officers reduce within the police department. The program will consist of times phases, with each phase lesting times veies. Lateral officers will be required to attend one three weeks phases. All trainess will be required to receive training in all the specified areas covered in this policy. Field Training Officers (FTO) will be required to receive veies the program of the program o

(Os will also regularly scheduled meetings established by the to coordinator and the training supervisor. The purpose of the meetings will be to evaluate the training program and suggest changes to be implemented to the training purpose. All changes suggested must be accepted and approved by the administration prior to being added to the program.

Phase one of the program will consist of training in the following:

- Tremee will observe the operations of each division within the department
 - A. First training officer will ensure that all subject matter is covered and will be required to sign off on the training. The trainer will also be required to critical next to the covered material on the field training report. The division commander or representative of the division commander will be required to sign the bottom of the field training report.

The conduct and profidency report will advise as to whether or not the trained has setsfactority completed all phases of training. The report will be reviewed by the F.T.O coordinator and reaming coordinator and be submitted to the administration for final approval. Upon tittel approval by the E.T.O coordinator and considered and the released to full active duty.

Enteral utilizers will be required to pass a three-week phase of training. The amount of time spein within a phase of training shall be determined by the Field Training Officer. Field Training Officers may submit a concord and profiberacy report advising that a particular trainee has satisfactorily completed all required fields of training. Upon approval by the administration the barrier may be placed on duty without further training.

The jumpose of the lateral training program is to ensure that of leteral training officers should incorporate and understanding of how the petal police department operates. Field Training Officers should incorporate primarily phase one into the lateral training phase.

During this phase the trainee will receive instruction or, and buserve me operations of the count diery and warrants division. The trainee will receive instructions on warrants properties, and supposed is for court.
